Title: Melvin Kranzberg Dissertation Fellowship

Sponsor: Society for the History of Technology

Deadline: April 15, 2015

Description: \$4,000 award for a doctoral student engaged in the preparation of a dissertation on the history of technology, broadly defined. Applicants must have completed all requirements for their doctorate except for the dissertation by September 1 of the award year.
