February 1, 2017

Spring, Summer, and Fall internships available at Wolf Trap National Park for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C. to foster the next generation of arts leaders. 12-week program with flexible start & end dates.

Educational Testing Service (ETS) Summer Internship Program in Research

February 1, 2017

Students will be selected to participate in ongoing research projects under the supervision of ETS senior staff. The program seeks to increase the number of women and minority professionals in educational measurement and related fields.

47th St. Gallen Symposium

February 1, 2017

Essay competition to participate in the 47th St. Gallen Symposium in Switzerland. The top 100 qualify as Leaders of Tomorrow and are invited to participate in the world's premier opportunity for intergenerational debates.

Center for Jewish History Graduate Research Fellowship

February 2, 2017

Residential ten-month fellowships for doctoral candidates to support original research using the collections of the Center's partners: American Jewish Historical Society, American Sephardi Federation, Leo Baeck Institute, Yeshiva University Museum, and YIVO, Institute for Jewish Research. Preference is given to those candidates who draw on the library and archival resources of more than one partner institution.

National Museum of the American Indian Internship Program

February 6, 2017

Internships are provided for students interested in the museum profession and related fields. Locations are in Maryland, Washington D.C. or New York for a duration of 10 weeks.

Mathematica Center Summer Fellowship in Disability Policy Research

February 10, 2017

Opportunity for students in master's programs or early in doctoral programs (pre-dissertation phase) to spend the summer of 2017 at Mathematica's Washington, DC office to learn more about conducting an independent research project related to disability policy.

Women Chemists Committee/Eli Lilly Travel Awards

February 15, 2017

Need-based grants offered to graduate and postdoctoral women chemists to travel and present the results of their research at scientific meetings.

Confucius China Studies Program Research Fellowships

February 15, 2017 (anticipated)

For qualified students who wish to pursue doctoral research in China. Funding awards range from six months to two years. Students from a wide range of academic areas focusing on China are encouraged to apply.

American Institute for Economic Research Summer Fellowship Practicum Program

February 15, 2017

The goal of the program is to provide accomplished individuals with an introduction to the Institute's mission, work, and research principles. Working closely with AIER research staff, summer fellows are immersed in the economic research process from "conception to completion". The AIER Practicum enhances Fellows' understanding of economic concepts, theories, and real world applications, and provides an opportunity to develop research, writing, and presentation skills.

Smithsonian Institution—STRI Short-Term Fellowship Program

February 15, 2017; April 15, 2017

Provides support for graduate students and introduces them to tropical research. These fellowships enable selected candidates to work in the topics and explore research possibilities at STRI.

University Research Association Visiting Scholars Program

February 27, 2017

Funding for visits to work at Fermilab as a visiting scholar for up to one year. Visits can range from attendance at Fermilab conferences and summer schools to year-long stays at the Lab.

The Mariam K. Chamberlain Fellowship in Women and Public Policy

February 28, 2017

\$31,000, nine-month fellowships at the Institute for Women's Policy Research assist in the professional development of students and graduates interested in economic and educational support for women.

Sigma Delta Pi Graduate Research Grant

March 1, 2017

Research grants for active members of Sigma Delta Pi to travel to Spain and Spanish America for research related to Hispanic Studies.

Dissertation Fellowships in Early American Economy & Society

March 1, 2017

One dissertation research fellowship and four one-month fellowships for research of the American economy and society, from its colonial beginnings to the 1850s. Possible topics include global trade, internal development, politics, the relationship between race/gender and economic forces, and capitalism. Awards provide support for research in residence at The Library Company of Philadelphia.

American Philosophical Society Library Short-Term Resident Research Fellowships

March 1, 2017

Short-term residential fellowships for conducting research in the American Philosophical Society Library.

Sir John Soane's Museum Foundation Traveling Fellowship Program

March 1, 2017

\$5,000 fellowships support travel to London to pursue research projects related to the Sir John Soane's Museum or its collections.

Arena Stage Allen Lee Hughes Fellowship and Internship Program

March 3, 2017

Program is designed to cultivate the next generation of theater professionals by providing the highest standard of training through immersion in the art and business of producing theater.

NASW Foundation Social Work HEALS Policy Fellowship

March 8, 2017

One-year fellowship through the National Association of Social Workers to social workers who have completed at least two years of a doctoral program. Fellows will participate in a social work specific opportunity to use their social work knowledge and research experience to work in Washington, D.C. on critical health policy issues facing our nation.

Universität Kassel International Summer University Scholarships

March 12, 2017

Scholarships available for a graduate student who wishes to take part in the Nano Science module of the International Summer University at Kassel in 2017.

Gerald R. Ford Presidential Foundation Research Travel Grants

March 15, 2017

Grants up to \$2,200 in support of research in the holdings of the Gerald R. Ford Library in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The grant may be used to defray travel costs and living expenses.

American Jewish Historical Society

Sid and Ruth Lapidus Fellowship

April 20, 2017 (anticipated)

Supports one or more researcher(s) wishing to use the collections of the American Jewish Historical Society. Preference is given to researchers interested in 17th and 18th century American Jewish history. At the discretion of the awards committee, the fellowship funds may also be applied to subsidizing publication of a first book in the field of American Jewish history, again with preference given to works in early American Jewish history. The available amount for the award(s) is \$6,000 annually.

Ruth B. Fein Prize

April 20, 2017 (anticipated)

A travel stipend established in honor of a past president of the Society, to a graduate student to help undertake research at the American Jewish Historical Society. The award is up to \$1,000.

Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey Fellowships

April 7, 2017; October 7, 2017 (anticipated)

Fellowships for international PhD students to pursue their research in Turkey. The program aims to promote Turkey's scientific and technological collaboration with countries of the prospective researchers.

Tampa Bay Seminole Club Graduate Student Scholarship

April 30, 2017 (anticipated)

It is the goal of the Tampa Bay Seminole club to continue our commitment towards further building a pipeline between Hillsborough and Pasco county high schools and Florida State University. Candidates must be a graduate of a Hillsborough or Pasco county high school and have proof of acceptance into a graduate program at FSU or graduate coursework completed.

Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM) Student Travel Awards

Deadline: Seven months before the first day of the conference for which support is requested. Travel awards to help students attend and present at SIAM conferences.

Institute for Humane Studies Conference and Research Grant

Deadline: Rolling, at least four weeks before activity for which you are seeking funding Grants awarded to graduate students advancing the principles of freedom through their career to present at academic or professional conferences, travel to academic job interviews on a campus or at a conference, travel to archives or libraries for research, and participate in career-development seminars.

The Center for Jewish History Steinberg Fund for Emerging Jewish Filmmakers

Deadline: Rolling

Funding for projects whose subject matter is in line with the collections housed at the Center for Jewish History and who plan to do research at the Center's archives in New York. The goal of this fellowship is to provide small stipends to emerging filmmakers working on topics related to modern Jewish history and is not limited to film students.

February 1, 2017

Grants to support underwater science, environmental projects, and education.

American Cancer Society Graduate Scholarships in Cancer Nursing

February 1, 2017

Supports graduate students pursuing a master's degree in cancer nursing or doctorate of nursing practice (DNP) Awards may be for two years with a stipend of \$10,000 per year.

Government Finance Officers Association Scholarships

February 10, 2017

Daniel B. Goldberg Scholarship: A non-renewable \$14,000 scholarship offered to a full-time graduate student who is preparing for a career in state and local government finance.

Government Finance Professional Development Scholarship: Supports part-time graduate students in public administration, finance, business administration or a related field.

Minorities in Government Finance Scholarship: Scholarship for minority students in public administration, accounting, finance, political science, economics or business administration (with a specific focus on government or nonprofit management.).

Frank L. Greathouse Government Accounting Scholarship: For graduate students preparing for a career in state and local government finance in the United States or Canada.

Opportunity for graduate students to work with members of the Great Lakes science, policy and education communities to advance the environmental quality and sustainable economic goals of the Great Lakes states.

NASA Education Aeronautics Scholarship and Advanced STEM Training Research (AS&ASTAR) Fellowship

February 24, 2017

Support for graduate students pursuing a degree in STEM while partaking in unique research projects under the guidance of an institutional Principal Investigator in collaboration with NASA Technical Advisers.

Archives of American Art Fellowships and Internships

February 25, 201

Multiple internships of at least 10 weeks for students interested in archival science, information management, museum studies, art, administration, art history, and cultural studies.

LAGRANT Graduate Scholarships

February 28, 2017 by 5pm

Awards for minority students pursuing a graduate degree in advertising, marketing or public relations. Scholarship winners will receive a trip to Detroit in order to participate in career building activities.

American Society for Theater Research Fellowship

March 2017 (anticipated)

Funding to underwrite some of the research expenses of scholars undertaking projects significant to the field of theatre and/or performance studies. Must have been a member of ASTR for 3 of the last 5 years. *See website for more funding opportunities.

American Library Association Miriam L. Hornback Scholarship

March 1, 2017

Annual scholarship to an ALA or library support staffer who is a U.S./Canadian citizen or permanent resident who is pursuing an MLS in an ALA-accredited program.

Neotropical Grassland Conservancy (NGC) Student Grant Program (SGP)

March 1, 2017

Foundation's mission is promoting the conservation of savannas, gallery forests, wetlands, and associated ecosystems in Central and South America. The SGP supports graduate research projects that are often hindered by lack of funds for basic needs such as transportation, lodging, meals & consumable field supplies.

Fellowships to individuals desiring to become a teacher of American history, American government, or social studies at the secondary school level.

March 1, 2017

National Association of Social Workers Foundation Fellowships and Scholarships March 1, 2016

Consuelo W. Gosnell Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to master's degree candidates who have demonstrated a commitment to working with, or who have special affinity with, American Indian/Alaska Native & Hispanic/Latino populations, or in public & voluntary nonprofit agency settings.

Verne LaMarr Lyons Scholarship: Grant awarded to master's degree candidates in social work who demonstrate an interest in, or have experience with, health/mental health practice and a commitment to working in African American communities.

Semi-Annual Excellence in Medicine Student Scholarship

March 1, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students currently enrolled in a school of medicine in the U.S. or Canada.

Education for Sustainable Energy Development Scholarship

March 10, 2017

Support for outstanding international students (citizens of the developing countries and territories identified on the website) pursuing advanced studies in sustainable energy development.

National Strength and Conditioning Association Grants and Scholarships

March 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Grants and Scholarships for students researching questions related to strength training and/or conditioning.

Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation Scholarships

March 18, 2017

Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$10,000 for research in nutrition and dietetics.

Communicative Disorders Scholarship

March 30, 2017

Scholarship for graduate students in audiology or speech-language pathology.

International Furnishings and Design Association Scholarships

March 31, 2017

Vercille Voss IFDA Graduate Student Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students. Must have already completed four design courses at the graduate level.

Ruth Clark Furniture Design Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students whose emphasis is on residential furniture design.

American Society of Interior Designers Scholarships and Awards

April 2017 (anticipated)

Space Medicine Association (SMA) Jeffrey R. Davis Scholarship

April 1, 2017

German-Canadian Studies Fellowship Competition

April 15, 2017

It is awarded on an annual basis for the most promising Master's thesis project in German-Canadian history by a student enrolled in the Universities of Winnipeg and Manitoba's Joint Master's Program in History, working under the supervision of the Chair in German-Canadian Studies at the University of Winnipeg.

ORISE Evaluation Fellowship Opportunity at the CDC

April 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Fellows work under the leadership of the CDC's chief Evaluation Officer; they are matched with CDC host programs to work on program evaluation activities for/with those programs. Host programs are selected through a competitive process to ensure the activities build the knowledge base of the program and enhance the professional development of the Fellow.

Arthur C. Pike Scholarship in Meteorology

A scholarship from the National Weather Association for students majoring in meteorology.

Mary Murphy Graduate Scholarship

April 15, 2017

Honors a Delta Sigma Theta Sorority chapter member who placed great value on education and community service. This scholarship was established for professional women who follow Mary Murphy's example.

International Federation for Ethical Research Graduate Fellowship Program for Alternatives to the Use of Animals in Science

April 29, 2017 (anticipated)

The purpose of IFER's Fellowship Program is to provide financial incentives to graduate students in science that encourage them at the earliest stages of their career to integrate innovation and discovery with ethics and respect for animals.

Student Leadership Awards

April 30, 2017 (anticipated)

Sponsored by HENAAC, \$1,000 scholarship for STEM graduate students of Hispanic decent that demonstrates leadership excellence.

American Planning Association Judith McManus Price Scholarship

April 30, 2017

Support for women and minority students enrolled in an approved planning program who are U.S. citizens, intend to pursue careers as practicing planners in the public sector, and are able to demonstrate a genuine financial need.

Philanthropic Educational Organization (P.E.O.) Program for Continuing Education

Deadline: 3-4 months prior to the start of the term for which the grant is requested

One-time need based grants to women who are citizens or legal permanent residents of the U.S. or Canada for use in completing a degree or certification necessary for improving or gaining skills leading to employment.



Harry Frank Guggenheim Dissertation Fellowships

February 1, 2017

Fellowships intended to support doctoral students in completing the writing of a dissertation. Questions that interest the foundation concern violence and aggression in relation to social change, intergroup conflict, war, terrorism, crime, and family relationships, among other subjects.

Jefferson Scholars Foundation National Fellowship

February 1, 2017

Funds scholars completing dissertations that employ history to shed light on American politics and public policy, foreign relations and the impact of global affairs on the US, media and politics, and the role of the presidency in shaping American political development.

Harry S. Truman Library Dissertation Year Fellowship

February 1, 2017

Dissertation Year Fellowships that are intended to encourage historical scholarship of the public career of Harry S. Truman or the Truman era. This fellowship is intended to free a doctoral student from teaching or other employment to facilitate completion of his or her dissertation.

PADI Foundation Grant

February 1, 2017

Grants to support underwater science, environmental projects, and education.

Lewis and Clark Fund for Exploration and Field Research

February 1, 2017

Exploratory field studies for the collection of specimens and data for doctoral students up to \$5,000.

PhRMA Pre Doctoral Fellowships

February 1, 2017

Fellowships for students who expect to complete their Ph.D. in two years or less from the time the fellowship begins. Fellowships are offered in five areas: Adherence Improvement, Health Outcomes, Informatics, Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology/Toxicology.

American Meteorological Society Graduate Fellowships

February 3, 2017

Fellowship in the History of Science: For PhD students in the dissertation writing stage. Carries a \$15,000 stipend to support one year of research.

Minority Scholarships: Funding for minority students who have been traditionally underrepresented in the sciences, especially Hispanic, Native American, and Black/African American students.

American Heart Association Predoctoral Fellowship

February 9, 2017

For research broadly related to cardiovascular function and disease and stroke, or to related clinical, basic science, bioengineering or biotechnology, and public health problems, including multidisciplinary efforts.

National Science Foundation Doctoral Dissertation Research Improvement Awards

Sociology: February 9, 2017 | Geography and Spatial Sciences: February 28, 2017

Doctoral dissertation improvement grants to promote scientific research, advance theory, facilitate education and training, and enhance the capabilities of current and future researchers.

Dr. Francis Anthony Beneventi Medical Scholarship: Scholarship for a student either attending or planning to attend an approved, accredited medical school, college or university.

Arthur Lockwood Beneventi Law Scholarship: One-time scholarship awarded to a student who is either enrolled in or attends an accredited law school.

DAR Centennial Scholarship: Scholarship for students pursuing a course of graduate study in the field of historic preservation at a college or university in the United States.

Irene and Daisy MacGregor Memorial Scholarship: Scholarship for students of high scholastic standing and character who have been accepted into or are pursuing an approved course of study to become a medical doctor at an approved, accredited medical school. Also available to students in the field of psychiatric nursing at the graduate level.

Fellowships sponsored by Resources for the Future for doctoral dissertation research on issues related to the environment, natural resources, or energy. Supports graduate students in the final year of their dissertation research. RFF's primary research disciplines are economics and other social sciences, and proposals originating in these fields will have the greatest likelihood of success. Proposals from the physical or biological sciences must have an immediate and obvious link to environmental policy matters.

National Association of Social Workers Foundation Eileen Blackey Doctoral Fellowship

March 1, 2017 (anticipated)

Fellowship for social work doctoral candidates who are engaged in dissertation research in welfare policy and practice.

American Society for Theater Research Fellowship

March 2017 (anticipated)

Israel Institute Doctoral Fellowship

March 15, 2017

Two-year fellowships open to both doctoral students who are working on Israel as a primary topic of research and also to candidates whose focus is broader but whose work incorporates an Israeli dimension.

The Kevy Kaiserman Memorial Grant

March 15, 2017

Summer fellowships from the Myer and Rosaline Feinstein Center for American and Jewish History of up to \$3,000 to support research in the American Jewish experience.

Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation Scholarships

March 18, 2017

Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$10,000 for research in nutrition and dietetics.

Health Policy Research Scholars

American Planning Association Judith McManus Price Scholarship

April 30, 2017

Support for women and minority students enrolled in an approved planning program who are U.S. citizens, intend to pursue careers as practicing planners in the public sector, and are able to demonstrate a genuine financial need.

American Nurses Association Minority Fellowship Program
