Students should provide a copy of the completed application along with a signed transmittal form at least 3 business days before the deadline. ## Fulbright-Hays Fellow: Peter Hoelsing

In January 2010, Peter Hoelsing will continue his research in Uganda, supported by a Fulbright-Hays Doctoral Dissertation Research Abroad (DDRA) Fellowship. A Ph.D. candidate in Musicology, Hoelsing examines how ritual healers in Uganda use musical techniques to articulate categories of wellness. Hoelsing recorded ritual music extensively last year as an FSU International Dissertation Research Fellow. The Fulbright-Hays Fellowship will facilitate further field recording opportunities and enrich his interpretive research on these repertoires.



The Fulbright-Hays Fellowship, from the U.S. Department of Education, supports dissertation research abroad for a period of 6-12 months. This fellowship promotes foreign language and area studies in a variety of disciplines. Graduate students must submit proposals before the campus deadline in the fall.
