



### Upcoming Fellowship Deadlines October 6, 2015

#### TRAVEL AWARDS

##### **International Dissertation Research Fellowship (IDRF) Program**

Sponsor: SSRC/Mellon

Deadline: November 3, 2015

Description: Offers 9—12 months of support to graduate students enrolled in PhD programs in the US and conducting dissertation research on non-US topics.

Fields: Humanities and Social Sciences

##### **Henry Luce Foundation/ACLS Program in China Studies**

Location: China

Deadline: November 4, 2015

Description: Predissertation—summer travel grants, postdoctoral fellowships as well as collaborative reading-workshop grants available.

##### **Critical Language Scholarship Program**

Sponsor: U.S. Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs

Deadline: set to launch in October—deadline last year was in November

Description: Part of a U.S. government effort to expand dramatically the number of Americans studying and mastering critical foreign languages. Participants are expected to continue their language study beyond the scholarship period, and later apply their critical language skills in their future professional careers.

Languages Supported: Azerbaijani, Bangla/Bengali, Hindi, Indonesian, Korean, Punjabi, Turkish, Urdu, Arabic, Persian, Chinese, Japanese, and Russian

##### **John Carter Brown Library Research Fellowships**

Location: Brown University, Rhode Island

Deadline: December 1, 2015

Description: Approximately 40 fellowships are awarded to scholars each year to pursue research at the John Carter Brown Library to research centered on the colonial history of the Americas (North and South), including all aspects of the European, African, and Native American involvement.

Fields: Social Sciences and Humanities

##### **Leifur Eiríksson Foundation Scholarship Program**

Location: Iceland

Deadline: December 7, 2015

Description: For graduate research or study at universities in Iceland. Up to \$25,000 in project costs, including travel to and from the research or study site will be paid on the scholar's behalf.

##### **DAAD Fellowships**

Location: Germany

Deadline: Varies—many in December

Description: Grants for intensive language courses, summer courses, science internships, short and long term research grants.

#### MASTERS

**La Unidad Latina Foundation (LALF) Scholarship**

Deadline: October 15, 2015

Description: Educational scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$1,000

Fields: All

**American Concrete Institute (ACI) Foundation Fellowship and Scholarship**

Deadline: October 18, 2015

Description: Scholarships for eligible graduate students whose studies relate to concrete. Unlike the ACI Foundation Fellowships, those applying for scholarships do not need to be nominated by ACI-Member Faculty

Fields: STEM

**NSF Graduate Research Fellowship Program (GRFP)**

Deadline: October 26—October 30th depending on discipline

Description: Recognizes and supports outstanding graduate students in NSF-supported disciplines who are pursuing research-based master's and doctoral degrees at accredited US institutions.

Fields: STEM and Social Sciences

**Paul and Daisy Soros Foundation Fellowship for New Americans**

Deadline: November 1, 2015

Description: Support for New Americans, i.e., green card holders, naturalized citizens, or the children of naturalized citizens. Fellowships are for up to two years; applicants must not yet be 31 years old at the time of application

Fields: Any

**Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) Student Scholarship Program**

Deadline: November 1, 2015

Description: Scholarships may be used for undergraduate or master's degree programs with an emphasis area in HR or an HR-related program (such as business, psychology or labor relations)

**Kate Neal Kinley Memorial Fellowship**

Deadline: December 1, 2015

Description: Open to students whose principal or major studies have been in the fields of art, architecture, dance, landscape architecture, music, theatre, or urban and regional planning.

Fields: Humanities

**American Association of University Women (AAUW) Career Development Grants**

Deadline: December 15, 2015

Description: Awards for women who are preparing to reenter the work force, change careers, or advance their current careers. Funds are provided for tuition, fees, books, transportation, and dependent care.

#### PREDISSERTATION

**Social Science Research Council (SSRC) Dissertation Proposal Development Fellowship (DPDF)**

Deadline: October 15, 2015

Description: Designed to help early-stage graduate students in the humanities and social sciences formulate innovative dissertation research proposals through workshops, exploratory summer research, and writing guided by peer review and faculty mentorship.

Fields: Humanities and Social Sciences

**Hertz Foundation Graduate Fellowships**

Deadline: October 30, 2015

Description: Supports graduate students working towards the PhD degree in the applied physical, biological, and engineering sciences.

Fields: STEM

**NSF Graduate Research Fellowship Program (GRFP)**

Deadline: October 26—October 30th depending on discipline

Description: Recognizes and supports outstanding graduate students in NSF-supported disciplines who are pursuing research-based master's and doctoral degrees at accredited US institutions.

Fields: STEM and Social Sciences

**Paul and Daisy Soros Fellowship for New Americans**

Deadline: November 1, 2015

Description: Fellows will receive tuition and stipend assistance of up to \$90,000 in support of graduate education in the United States. Students must be under the age of 31, in their first or second year of their graduate program, and a New American.

Fields: Any

**Amelia Earhart Fellowships**

Sponsor: Zonta International Foundation

Deadline: November 15, 2015

Description: Established in 1938 in honor of Amelia Earhart, famed pilot and Zonta club member. The \$10,000 Fellowships are granted annually to women pursuing PhD degrees in aerospace-related sciences or aerospace-related engineering.

**Ford Foundation Predoctoral Fellowship**

Deadline: November 20, 2015

Description: 3 year fellowship for doctoral students who plan to pursue a faculty position and use diversity to enhance the learning experience for students.

Fields: Research based degree—see website for details

Fields: Any

**American Association of University Women (AAUW) International Fellowships**

Deadline: December 1, 2015

Description: Women who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents. The overwhelming majority of fellows return to their home countries to become leaders.

#### **PREDISSERTATION (continued)**

##### **SMART Fellowship**

Sponsor: Department of Defense

Deadline: December 1, 2015

Description: Supports undergraduate and graduate students pursuing degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics disciplines. The program aims to increase the number of civilian scientists and engineers working at DoD laboratories.

Fields: STEM

##### **National Physical Science Consortium Graduate Fellowships in Science, Engineering and Math**

Deadline: December 5, 2015

Description: Fellowships for graduate students in Astronomy, Chemistry, Computer Science, Geology, Materials Science, Mathematical Sciences, Physics, and related Engineering fields. Initial support may be for 2 to 3 years, or a full 6 years, depending on the employer-sponsor.

##### **DOE Office of Science Graduate Student Research (SCGSR)**

Deadline: December 15, 2015

Description: Prepares graduate students for science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) careers critically important to the DOE Office of Science mission, by providing graduate thesis research opportunities at DOE laboratories.

##### **The Howard Mayer Brown Fellowship**

Sponsor: American Musicological Society, INC

Deadline: December 15, 2015

Description: One fellowship is awarded annually to increase the presence of minority scholars and teachers in musicology. The fellowship will support one year of graduate work for an underrepresented student in musicology at a North American University.

##### **National Defense Science and Engineering Graduate (NDSEG) Fellowship**

Sponsor: Department of Defense

Deadline: December

Description: A means of increasing the number of U.S. citizens and nationals trained in science and engineering disciplines of military importance, from the Department of Defense (DoD)

##### **P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship**

Deadline: Eligibility form must be completed by December 15th

Description: The International Peace Scholarship Fund, established in 1949, is a program which provides scholarships for selected women from other countries for graduate study in the United States and Canada.

#### DISSERTATION

**Smith Richardson Foundation World Politics and Statecraft Fellowship**

Deadline: October 15, 2015

Description: Grants to support PhD dissertation research on American foreign policy, international relations, international security, strategic studies, area studies and diplomatic and military history. The fellowship's objective is to support the research and writing of policy-relevant dissertations through funding of fieldwork, archival research and language training.

**Woodrow Wilson Foundation Dissertation Completion Fellowships in Women's Studies**

Deadline: October 15, 2014

Description: Enable doctoral students to complete their dissertations on research about women that crosses disciplinary, regional, or cultural boundaries.

**Luce Foundation Dissertation Fellowships in American Art**

Sponsor: American Council for Learned Societies

Deadline: October 21, 2015

Description: Ten one-year fellowships will provide stipends of \$25,000 to art history graduate students working on a dissertation related to the history of the visual arts in the United States.

**Andrew W. Mellon Fellowship for Dissertation Completion**

Deadline: October 21, 2015

Description: Supports a year of research and writing to help advanced graduate students in the humanities and related social sciences in their last year of PhD dissertation writing. Applicants must be prepared to complete their dissertations within the one-year fellowship period.

**American Educational Research Association (AERA) Minority Dissertation Fellowship in Education Research**

Description: Female candidates are evaluated on the basis of scholarly excellence, quality and originality of project design, and active commitment to helping women and girls through service in their communities, professions, or fields of research.

##### **Ford Foundation Dissertation Fellowships**

Deadline: November 20, 2015

Description: Ford Foundation seeks to increase the diversity of the nation's college and university faculties by increasing their ethnic and racial diversity, maximizing the educational benefits of diversity, and increasing the number of professors who can and will use diversity as a resource for enriching the education of all students.
