Travel

University Research Association Visiting Scholars Program

August 29, 2016

Funding for visits to work at Fermilab for up to one year. Supports work in high energy physics, astrophysics, theory, accelerator physics, materials science, and computer science.

Mid Atlantic Arts Foundation US Artists International Grants

September 4, 2016

Funding for American artists to perform at important cultural festivals and art marketplaces around the globe.

Christine Mirzayan Science and Technology Policy Graduate Fellowship Program

September 6, 2016

Spend 12 weeks in winter/spring at the National Academies in Washington, DC, learning about science and technology policy and the role that scientists and engineers play in advising the nation. Applicants become part of a National Academies committee, board, or unit where they are assigned to a mentor and learn about the world of science and technology policy.

Women Chemists Committee/Eli Lilly Travel Awards

September 15, 2016

Need-based grants offered to graduate and postdoctoral women chemists to travel and present the results of their research at scientific meetings.

Humboldt Foundation German Chancellor Fellowship for Prospective Leaders

September 15, 2016

Conduct independent projects in a broad range of fields such as politics, public administration, and business, as well as society and culture, at a host institution in Germany for one year, network with other prospective leaders from abroad and explore new solutions to the global issues of our times.

Harry S. Truman Library Research Grant

October 1, 2016

Research Grants of up to \$2,500 are awarded twice annually to offset the cost of conducting research at the Harry S. Truman Library and Museum.

The Society for Historians of American Foreign Relations Dissertation Research Grants

October 1, 2016

W. Stull Holt Dissertation Fellowship: Fellowship intended to defray the costs of travel necessary to conduct research on a significant dissertation project for students whose dissertation deals with some aspect of U.S. foreign relations history. Applicants for this award will be considered automatically for the Stuart L. Bernath, Gelfand-Rappaport-LaFeber, and Bemis grants.

Lawrence Gelfand – Armin Rappaport – Walter LeFeber Dissertation Fellowship: Fellowship intended to defray the costs of dissertation research travel for students actively working on dissertations dealing with some aspect of U.S. foreign relations history. Applicants for this award will be considered automatically for the Stuart L. Bernath, Holt, and Bemis grants.

Samuel Flagg Bemis Dissertation Research Grant: Fellowship to help defray the costs of domestic or international travel necessary to conduct research on significant scholarly projects for students actively working on dissertations dealing with some aspect of U.S. foreign relations history. Applicants for this award will be considered automatically for the Stuart L. Bernath, Holt, and Gelfand-Rappaport-LaFeber grants.

Fulbright U.S. Student Program Awards

Campus deadlines: September 7 & 8, 2016

National Application deadline: October 11, 2016

The Fulbright U.S. Student Program sponsored by the U.S. State Department offers research, study, and teaching opportunities in over 140 countries to recent graduates and graduate students. All fields of study are acceptable unless otherwise indicated in a country's listing.

Naval Research Enterprise Internship Program

October 23, 2016 (anticipated)

Summer internships for STEM students to participate in research at a Department of Navy laboratory.

Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM) Student Travel Awards

Deadline: Seven months before the first day of the conference for which support is requested

Travel awards to help students attend and present at SIAM conferences.

NCAA Graduate Student Research Grant

August 12, 2016

Research grants for students in the social and behavioral sciences conducting research within the general areas of student-athlete psychosocial well-being and college athletics participation.

American Musicological Society Noah Greenberg Award

August 15, 2016

The award is intended as a grant-in-aid to stimulate active cooperation between scholars and performers by recognizing and fostering outstanding contributions to historical performing practices.

Pediatric Endocrinology Nursing Society Academic Education Scholarship

September 1, 2017

Scholarship to advance the art and science of pediatric endocrine nursing.

Craft Fund Graduate Research Grant

September 17, 2016

Grants to support research for a master's thesis related to U.S. studio craft for students in arts, architecture, education, and information studies.

AHIMA Foundation Scholarships

September 30, 2016

Merit Scholarships: Support for master's students in areas related to Health Information Management (HIM) or Health Informatics Technology (HIT).

Veterans Scholarships: Scholarships for veterans and their spouses in Health Informatics and Information Management programs.

American Water Works Association Academic Achievement Award

October 1, 2016

Recognizes contributions to the field of public water supply. All master's theses and doctoral dissertations relevant to the water supply industry.

Archives of American Art Fellowships and Internships

October 1, 2016

Multiple internships of at least 10 weeks for students interested in archival science, information management, museum studies, art, administration, art history, and cultural studies.

Biographical Society of America Justin G. Schiller Prize for Bibliographical Work on Pre-20th Century Children's Books

October 15, 2016 (anticipated)

Encourages scholarship in the bibliography of historical children's books. Works put into nomination (English only) may concentrate on any children's book printed before the year 1901 in any country.

American Nephrology Nurses Association Education Scholarships and Grants

October 15, 2016

Support for members in their pursuit of higher education as well as grants for clinical research projects and patient or staff education programs.

Paul Farmer Global Surgery Fellowship Research Associate

October 15, 2016

One-year position for medical students who wish to take time off between their 3rd and 4th year of medical school, as well as for those who are enrolled in a health-related graduate degree program with an interest in global surgical care.

Acton Institute for the Study of Religion and Liberty Calihan Academic Fellowship

October 15, 2016

Scholarships and grants for graduate students currently studying theology, philosophy, economics, or related fields who demonstrate the potential to advance understanding in the relationship between theology and the principles of the free and virtuous society, such as recognition of human dignity, the importance of the rule of law, limited government, religious liberty, and freedom in economic life.

American Concrete Institute Foundation Fellowship and Scholarship

October 18, 2016 (anticipated)

Scholarships for eligible graduate students whose studies relate to concrete. Unlike the ACI Foundation Fellowships, those applying for scholarships do not need to be nominated by ACI-Member Faculty.

International Centre for Diffraction Data Ludo Frevel Crystallography Scholarships

October 19, 2016

Scholarships for graduate students with major interest in crystallography.

Hertz Foundation Graduate Fellowship Award

October 28, 2016

Cost-of-education allowance and a stipend for STEM students willing to make their skills available to U.S. in time of national emergency, such as fuel shortages, transportation and communication system overloads, deterioration of environmental quality, and malevolent utilization of cyberspace.

Philanthropic Educational Organization (P.E.O.) Program for Continuing Education

Deadline: Between 4 months & 10 weeks prior to the start of the term for which the grant is requested
One-time need based grants to women who are citizens or legal permanent residents of the U.S. or Canada for use in completing a degree or certification necessary for improving or gaining skills leading to employment.

Marketing Science Institute Clayton Fellowship for Dissertations in Marketing and Related Fields

August 8, 2016

The Marketing Science Institute is pleased to announce the 2016 Alden G. Clayton competition for the best doctoral dissertation proposals on important marketing subjects.

Epilepsy Foundation Research Grants Program

August 12, 2016

Supports pre-doctoral students with dissertation research related to epilepsy.

NCAA Graduate Student Research Grant

August 12, 2016

Research grants for social and behavioral sciences students conducting research within the general topic areas of student-athlete psychosocial well-being and college athletics participation.

American Educational Research Association Research and Dissertation Grants Program

August 25, 2016

This program seeks to stimulate research on U.S. education issues using data from the large scale, national and international data sets supported by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), NSF, and other federal agencies, and to increase the number of education researchers using these data sets. The program supports research projects that are quantitative in nature, include the analysis of existing data from NCES, NSF, or other federal agencies, and have U.S. education policy relevance.

Giva, Inc. Scholarships and Awards

Semi-Annual Outstanding Nursing Student Scholarship

September 1, 2016; March 2, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students currently enrolled in an accredited nursing program in the U.S. or Canada.

Semi-Annual Excellence in Medicine Student Scholarship

September 1, 2016; March 1, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students currently enrolled in a school of medicine in the U.S. or Canada.

SETAC/Procter & Gamble Doctoral Research Fellowship in Environmental Science

September 8, 2016

Supports the study, analysis and solution of environmental problems, the management and regulation of natural resources, research and development and environmental education.

American Psychological Association Dissertation Research Award

September 15, 2016

The purpose of the APA Science Directorate's Dissertation Research Award program is to assist science-oriented doctoral students of psychology with research costs. APA and its affiliate organizations provide a wide range of grants, scholarships, and awards (<http://www.apa.org/about/awards/index.aspx>) with the aim of advancing the science and practice of psychology as a means of understanding behavior and promoting health, education, and human welfare. The Dissertation Research award includes 30-40 grants of \$1,000 each, along with several larger grants of up to \$5,000 to students whose dissertation research reflects excellence in scientific psychology.

AHIMA Foundation Scholarships

September 30, 2016

Merit Scholarships: \$2,500 award for students pursuing a doctoral degree in areas related to Health Information Management (HIM) or Health Informatics Technology (HIT). One of the major initiatives of the AHIMA Foundation is to attract and support new talent in the HIM industry by improving educational opportunities for current and future HIM professionals through scholarships.

Veterans Scholarships: Scholarships for veterans and their spouses in Health Informatics and Information Management programs.

Dissertation Support: Support for doctoral students who are at the ABD stage.

Autism Speaks Dennis Weatherstone Pre-doctoral Fellowship Program

October 1, 2016 (anticipated)

Two-year fellowship for students interested in pursuing careers in autism research. Autism Speaks supports global biomedical research into the diagnosis, causes, prevention, and treatment of autism or its disabling symptoms. Funding supports the entire research continuum - from discovery to development to dissemination - for innovative projects that hold considerable promise for significantly improving the lives of those affected by autism.

American Water Works Association Academic Achievement Award

October 1, 2016

Recognizes contributions to the field of public water supply. All master's theses and doctoral dissertations relevant to the water supply industry.

Doctoral (Continued)

The Society for Historians of American Foreign Relations Dissertation Awards

Stuart L Bernath Dissertation Research Grant

October 1, 2016

Grant intended to help defray the expenses encountered in the writing of the dissertation by students working on dissertations dealing with some aspect of U.S. foreign relations history. Applicants for this award will be considered automatically for the Holt, Gelfand-Rappaport-LaFeber, and Bemis grants.

Myrna F. Bernath Fellowship

October 1, 2016

Fellowship intended to promote scholarship in U.S. foreign relations history by women. Awarded every two years (in odd years).

K. Patricia Cross Future Leaders Award

October 3, 2016

Recognizes doctoral students who show exemplary promise as future leaders of higher education, who demonstrate a commitment to developing academic and civic responsibility in themselves and others, and whose work reflects a strong emphasis on teaching and learning. Student must be nominated by a faculty member or administrator.

American Academy of Audiology Fellowships and Grants

October 5, 2016 (anticipated)

Student Summer Research Fellowship: This summer research fellowship is for students in a program in audiology or hearing science who wish to gain a limited, but significant, exposure to a research environment.

Student Investigator Research Grant: The purpose of this grant is to support doctoral students working toward a degree in audiology or hearing science who wish to complete a research project as part of their course of study.

National Academy of Education/Spencer Dissertation Fellowship

October 6, 2016

The Dissertation Fellowship Program seeks to encourage a new generation of scholars from a wide range of disciplines and professional fields to undertake research relevant to the improvement of education. These \$27,500 fellowships support individuals whose dissertations show potential for bringing fresh and constructive perspectives to the history, theory, analysis, or practice of formal or informal education anywhere in the world.

National Science Foundation Doctoral Dissertation Improvement Grants in the Directorate for Biological Sciences

October 13, 2016

The National Science Foundation awards Doctoral Dissertation Improvement Grants in selected areas of the biological sciences. Proposals must fall within the scope of any of the clusters in the Division of Environmental Biology (DEB) or the Behavioral Systems Cluster in the Division of Integrative Organismal Systems (IOS).

Smith Richardson Foundation World Politics and Statecraft Fellowship

October 14, 2016

Grants to support PhD dissertation research on American foreign policy, international relations, international security, strategic studies, area studies and diplomatic and military history. The fellowship's objective is to support the research and writing of policy-relevant dissertations through funding of fieldwork, archival research and language training.

Paul Farmer Global Surgery Fellowship Research Associate

October 15, 2016

One-year position for medical students who wish to take time off between their 3rd and 4th year of medical school, as well as for those who are enrolled in a health-related graduate degree program with an interest in global surgical care.

American Nephrology Nurses Association Education Scholarships and Grants

October 15, 2016

Support for members in their pursuit of higher education as well as grants for clinical research projects and patient or staff education programs.

Woodrow Wilson Dissertation Fellowship in Women's Studies

October 15, 2016

The Woodrow Wilson Dissertation Fellowship in Women's Studies encourages original and significant research about women that crosses disciplinary, regional, or cultural boundaries. Previous Fellows have explored such topics as transnational religious education for Muslim women, the complex gender dynamics of trans identity management, women's electoral success across racial and institutional contexts, women's sports, militarism and the education of American women, and the relationship between family commitments and women's work mobility.

International Centre for Diffraction Data Ludo Frevel Crystallography Scholarships

October 19, 2016

Scholarships for graduate students enrolled in graduate degree programs with major interest in crystallography.

Social Science Research Council Dissertation Proposal Development Fellowship Program

October 28, 2016

Helps early-stage doctoral students in the humanities and social sciences formulate innovative dissertation research proposals through workshops, exploratory summer research, and writing guided by peer review and faculty mentorship.

Doctoral (Continued)

American Council of Learned Societies Fellowships

October 26, 2016

ACLS/Mellon Dissertation Completion Fellowships

Support for advanced graduate students in the humanities and related social sciences in the last year of PhD dissertation writing. The program encourages timely completion of the PhD.

ACLS/Luce Dissertation Fellowships in American Art History

Support for graduate students in any stage of PhD dissertation research or writing on the history of the visual arts in the United States.

IBM Ph.D. Fellowship

October 27, 2016 (anticipated)

Fellowships honor exceptional Ph.D. students who have an interest in solving problems that are important to IBM and fundamental to innovation in many academic disciplines and areas of study, including: computer science and engineering; electrical and mechanical engineering; physical sciences; mathematical sciences; public sector and business sciences; and service science, management, and engineering (SSME) and industry solutions (healthcare, life sciences, education, energy & environment).

Hertz Foundation Graduate Fellowship Award

October 28, 2016

Cost-of-education allowance and a stipend for STEM students willing to make their skills available to U.S. in time of national emergency, such as fuel shortages, transportation and communication system overloads, deterioration of environmental quality, and malevolent utilization of cyberspace.

National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship Program (NSF GRFP)

Late October/Early November (depending on field of study)

Provides three years of support for the graduate education of individuals who have demonstrated their potential for significant achievements in science and engineering research. Students must be in their first or second year of a research based master's or PhD program and cannot have previously earned a master's degree. Open to students in STEM, STEM education, and the social sciences.
