Travel

RAND Graduate Student Summer Associate Program

January 5, 2017

Program designed to introduce students to RAND, an institution that conducts research on a wide range of national security problems and domestic and international social policy issues. Designed for full-time students who have completed at least two years of graduate work leading to a doctorate or professional degree (e.g., law, medicine, engineering) to work with Rand in Santa Monica, Washington DC, Pittsburgh, or Boston.

Kobe College Corporation/Japan Education Exchange - Graduate Fellowship Program

January 9, 2017

The KCC Japan Education Exchange Graduate Fellowships Program was established in 1996 to support qualified graduate students for research or study in Japan. The purpose of the fellowship is to support future American educators who will teach more effectively about Japan.

American School of Classical Studies at Athens Fellowships and Grants

January 15, 2017; February 15, 2017; March 15, 2017

One-year and short-term fellowships to travel to and study at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens

Chateaubriand Fellowship

January 27, 2017

Grant offered by the Embassy of France in the United States allowing doctoral students enrolled in American universities to conduct research in France for 4 to 9 months. Fellowships are available in two areas: STEM, Humanities & Social Sciences.

Boren Fellowship

January 31, 2017

Boren Fellowships provide unique funding opportunities for U.S. graduate students to study less commonly taught languages in world regions critical to U.S. interests, and underrepresented in study abroad, including Africa, Asia, Central and Eastern Europe, Eurasia, Latin America, and the Middle East. The countries of Western Europe, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand are excluded. Boren Fellows represent a vital pool of highly motivated individuals who wish to work in the federal national security arena. In exchange for funding, Boren Fellows commit to working in the federal government for at least one year after graduation.

Villers Fellowship for Health Care Justice

January 2017 (anticipated)

Year-long fellowship as a policy analyst for Families USA in Washington D.C. Commitment to social health care justice advocacy is expected.

Andrew W. Mellon Mediterranean Regional Research Fellowship

January 30, 2017

The Council of American Overseas Research Centers is pleased to offer a focused regional fellowship program enabling pre- and early postdoctoral scholars to carry out research in the humanities and related social sciences in countries bordering the Mediterranean and served by American overseas research centers. These fellowships foster international scholarship, education, and cultural dialogue.

The Multi-Country Research Fellowship

January 30, 2017

This Council of American Overseas Research Centers fellowship program supports advanced regional or trans-regional research in the humanities, social sciences, or allied natural sciences for U.S. doctoral candidates and scholars who have already earned their Ph.D. Preference will be given to candidates examining comparative and/or cross-regional research. Scholars must carry out research for a minimum of 90 days in two or more countries outside the United States, at least one of which hosts a participating American overseas research center.

Wolf Trap Internships

February 1, 2017

Spring, Summer, and Fall internships available at Wolf Trap National Park for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C. to foster the next generation of arts leaders. 12-week program with flexible start & end dates.

Educational Testing Service (ETS) Summer Internship Program in Research

February 1, 2017 (anticipated)

Students will be selected to participate in ongoing research projects under the supervision of ETS senior staff. The program seeks to increase the number of women and minority professionals in educational measurement and related fields.

47th St. Gallen Symposium

February 1, 2017

Essay competition to participate in the 47th St. Gallen Symposium in Switzerland. The top 100 qualify as Leaders of Tomorrow and are invited to participate in the world's premier opportunity for intergenerational debates.

Center for Jewish History Graduate Research Fellowship

February 2, 2017

Residential ten-month fellowships for doctoral candidates to support original research using the collections of the Center's partners: American Jewish Historical Society, American Sephardi Federation, Leo Baeck Institute, Yeshiva University Museum, and YIVO, Institute for Jewish Research. Preference is given to those candidates who draw on the library and archival resources of more than one partner institution.

National Museum of the American Indian Internship Program

February 6, 2017

Internships are provided for students interested in the museum profession and related fields. Locations are in Maryland, Washington D.C. or New York for a duration of 10 weeks.

Women Chemists Committee/Eli Lilly Travel Awards

February 15, 2017

Need-based grants offered to graduate and postdoctoral women chemists to travel and present the results of their research at scientific meetings.

Confucius China Studies Program Research Fellowships

February 15, 2017 (anticipated)

For qualified students who wish to pursue doctoral research in China. Funding awards range from six months to two years. Students from a wide range of academic areas focusing on China are encouraged to apply.

The Mariam K. Chamberlain Fellowship in Women and Public Policy

February 26, 2017 (anticipated)

\$31,000, nine-month fellowships at the Institute for Women's Policy Research assist in the professional development of students and graduates interested in economic and educational support for women.

University Research Association Visiting Scholars Program

February 27, 2017

Funding for visits to work at Fermilab as a visiting scholar for up to one year. Visits can range from attendance at Fermilab conferences and summer schools to year-long stays at the Lab.

Sigma Delta Pi Graduate Research Grant

March 1, 2017

Research grants for active members of Sigma Delta Pi to travel to Spain and Spanish America for research related to Hispanic Studies.

NASW Foundation Social Work HEALS Policy Fellowship

March 1, 2017 (anticipated)

One-year fellowship through the National Association of Social Workers to social workers who have completed at least two years of a doctoral program. Fellows will participate in a social work specific opportunity to use their social work knowledge and research experience to work in Washington, D.C. on critical health policy issues facing our nation.

American Philosophical Society Library Short-Term Resident Research Fellowships

March 1, 2017

Short-term residential fellowships for conducting research in the American Philosophical Society Library.

Dissertation Fellowships in Early American Economy & Society

March 1, 2017

One dissertation research fellowship and four one-month fellowships for research of the American economy and society, from its colonial beginnings to the 1850s. Possible topics include global trade, internal development, politics, the relationship between race/gender and economic forces, and capitalism. Awards provide support for research in residence at The Library Company of Philadelphia.

Sir John Soane's Museum Foundation Traveling Fellowship Program

March 1, 2017

\$5,000 fellowships support travel to London to pursue research projects related to the Sir John Soane's Museum or its collections.

Arena Stage Allen Lee Hughes Fellowship and Internship Program

March 11, 2017 (anticipated)

Program is designed to cultivate the next generation of theater professionals by providing the highest standard of training through immersion in the art and business of producing theater.

Universität Kassel International Summer University Scholarships

March 12, 2017

Scholarships available for a graduate student who wishes to take part in the Nano Science module of the International Summer University at Kassel in 2017.

Gerald R. Ford Presidential Foundation Research Travel Grants

March 15, 2017

Grants up to \$2,200 in support of research in the holdings of the Gerald R. Ford Library in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The grant may be used to defray travel costs and living expenses.

Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM) Student Travel Awards

Deadline: Seven months before the first day of the conference for which support is requested.

Travel awards to help students attend and present at SIAM conferences.

Institute for Humane Studies Conference and Research Grant

Deadline: Rolling, at least four weeks before activity for which you are seeking funding

Grants awarded to graduate students advancing the principles of freedom through their career to present at academic or professional conferences, travel to academic job interviews on a campus or at a conference, travel to archives or libraries for research, and participate in career-development seminars.

The Center for Jewish History Steinberg Fund for Emerging Jewish Filmmakers

Deadline: Rolling

Funding for projects whose subject matter is in line with the collections housed at the Center for Jewish History and who plan to do research at the Center's archives in New York. The goal of this fellowship is to provide small stipends to emerging filmmakers working on topics related to modern Jewish history and is not limited to film students.

Guy Harvey Scholarship Award

January 5, 2017 by 4 PM

Supports full time graduate students at Florida institutions of higher education who are conducting research related to the biology, ecology, habitat, or management of fish in Florida's marine environment.

American Association of Family & Consumer Sciences National Graduate Fellowship

January 9, 2017

Graduate fellowships for individuals who have exhibited the potential to make contributions to the family and consumer sciences profession, which encompasses the study of relationships among people and their personal environments in order to strengthen communities and advance the well-being of individuals and families.

American Water Works Association Scholarships

January 10, 2017

Numerous scholarships for students in the field of water works, including water science, water supply and treatment, aquatic chemistry, and environmental chemistry.

American Association of University Women (AAUW) Selected Professions Fellowships

January 10, 2017

Fellowships are awarded to women who intend to pursue a full-time course of study at accredited U.S. institutions during the fellowship year in architecture, computer/information sciences, engineering, and mathematics/statistics programs where women's participation traditionally has been low.

Humanity in Action - Summer Graduate Fellowship Program in Diplomacy and Diversity

January 13, 2017 (anticipated)

Fellows travel to Washington, D.C.; Berlin; and Warsaw to study how American and European governments and societies are responding to a wide range of international issues.

International Literacy Association Awards and Grants

January 15, 2017

Elva Knight Research Grant: Grant for research in reading and literacy

Jeanne S. Chall Research Fellowship: Grant to support reading research by promising scholars

Steven A. Stahl Research Grant: Support for graduate students who have at least three years of teaching experience and who are conducting classroom research

McKnight Doctoral Fellowship

January 15, 2017

Designed to address the under-representation of African American and Hispanic faculty at colleges and universities in Florida by increasing the pool of candidates qualified with Ph. D. degrees. Currently enrolled Ph.D students are not eligible.

Hurst Review/American Association of Colleges of Nursing Scholarship

January 15, 2017

Scholarships for students pursuing professional nursing degrees.

U.S. Department of Education EdSim Challenge

January 17, 2017

The U.S. Department of Education calls for concepts for immersive simulations that transfer academic, technical, and employability skills. Successful simulations will pair the engagement of commercial games with rigorous education content to prepare students for the 21st century workforce.

AAMFT Now Is The Time Minority Fellowship Program

January 20, 2017 (anticipated)

American Association of Marriage and Family Therapy Fellowship for master's students enrolled in a Marriage and Family Therapy master's program interested in service provision to the nation's youth.

American College of Sports Medicine Dr. Raymond A. Weiss Research Endowment

January 20, 2017

Established for ACSM students studying exercise science. One project will be funded for applied research, with the intent of applying the results to programs involving physical activity and sports. PADI Foundation Grant

February 1, 2017

February 1, 2017

Supports graduate students pursuing a master's degree in cancer nursing or doctorate of nursing practice (DNP).

Awards may be for two years with a stipend of \$10,000 per year.

Government Finance Officers Association Scholarships

Government Finance Professional Development Scholarship: Supports part-time graduate students in public administration, finance, business administration or a related field.

Minorities in Government Finance Scholarship: Scholarship for minority students in public administration, accounting, finance, political science, economics or business administration (with a specific focus on government or nonprofit management.).

Frank L. Greathouse Government Accounting Scholarship: For graduate students preparing for a career in state and local government finance in the United States or Canada.

Daughters of the American Revolution Scholarships

February 10, 2017

Scholarships supporting Political Science, History, Government & Economics, Medical School and Nursing, Law School, Business Administration, Music or Voice, STEM, and Education. See website for detailed information.

Florida Sea Grant John A. Knauss Marine Policy Fellowship

NASA Education Aeronautics Scholarship and Advanced STEM Training Research (AS&ASTAR) Fellowship

February 24, 2017

Support for graduate students pursuing a degree in STEM while partaking in unique research projects under the guidance of an institutional Principal Investigator in collaboration with NASA Technical Advisers.

Archives of American Art Fellowships and Internships

February 25, 2017

Multiple internships of at least 10 weeks for students interested in archival science, information management, museum studies, art, administration, art history, and cultural studies.

LAGRANT Graduate Scholarships

February 28, 2017 by 5pm

Awards for minority students pursuing a graduate degree in advertising, marketing or public relations. Scholarship winners will receive a trip to Detroit in order to participate in career building activities.

American Society for Theater Research Fellowship

March 2017 (anticipated)

Funding to underwrite some of the research expenses of scholars undertaking projects significant to the field of theatre and/or performance studies. Must have been a member of ASTR for 3 of the last 5 years.

American Library Association Miriam L. Hornback Scholarship

March 1, 2017

Annual scholarship to an ALA or library support staffer who is a U.S./Canadian citizen or permanent resident who is pursuing an MLS in an ALA-accredited program.

Neotropical Grassland Conservancy (NGC) Student Grant Program (SGP)

March 1, 2017

Foundation's mission is promoting the conservation of savannas, gallery forests, wetlands, and associated ecosystems in Central and South America. The SGP supports graduate research projects that are often hindered by lack of funds for basic needs such as transportation, lodging, meals & consumable field supplies.

James Madison Graduate Fellowships

March 1, 2017 (anticipated)

Fellowships to individuals desiring to become a teacher of American history, American government, or social studies at the secondary school level.

National Association of Social Workers Foundation Fellowships and Scholarships

March 1, 2016

Consuelo W. Gosnell Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to master's degree candidates who have demonstrated a commitment to working with, or who have special affinity with, American Indian/Alaska Native & Hispanic/Latino populations, or in public & voluntary nonprofit agency settings.

Verne LaMarr Lyons Scholarship: Grant awarded to master's degree candidates in social work who demonstrate an interest in, or have experience with, health/mental health practice and a commitment to working in African American communities.

Giva, Inc. Scholarships and Awards

Semi-Annual Excellence in Medicine Student Scholarship

March 1, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students currently enrolled in a school of medicine in the U.S. or Canada.

Florida Gubernatorial Fellows Program

March 14, 2017 (anticipated)

Non-partisan program immerses students from public and private universities in key areas of state government.

National Strength and Conditioning Association Grants and Scholarships

March 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Grants and Scholarships for students researching questions related to strength training and/or conditioning.

Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation Scholarships

March 18, 2017

Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$10,000 for research in nutrition and dietetics.

Communicative Disorders Scholarship

March 30, 2017

Scholarship for graduate students in audiology or speech-language pathology.

International Furnishings and Design Association Scholarships

March 31, 2017

Vercille Voss IFDA Graduate Student Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students. Must have already completed four design courses at the graduate level.

Ruth Clark Furniture Design Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students whose emphasis is on residential furniture design.

Philanthropic Educational Organization (P.E.O.) Program for Continuing Education

Deadline: 3-4 months prior to the start of the term for which the grant is requested

One-time need based grants to women who are citizens or legal permanent residents of the U.S. or Canada for use in completing a degree or certification necessary for improving or gaining skills leading to employment.



Egg Nutrition Center Grant/Fellowship Program

January 1, 2017 (anticipated)

Grant/Fellowship program for those studying the nutritional value of eggs and egg-related nutrients and the role of eggs in a healthy diet.

American Geosciences Institute Harriet Evelyn Wallace Doctoral Student Scholarships for Women

January 4, 2017

American Geosciences Institute Scholarship that supports female geoscientists pursuing a doctoral degree. Scholarships provide two years of support. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

Guy Harvey Scholarship Award

January 5, 2017 by 4 PM

Supports full time graduate students at Florida institutions of higher education who are conducting research related to the biology, ecology, habitat, or management of fish in Florida's marine environment.

American Medical Association Seed Grant Research Program

January 6, 2017

Grants to support medical students, physician residents, & fellows in conducting small research projects. In 2017, the AMA Foundation will be awarding grants up to \$2,500 in the areas of cardiovascular pulmonary diseases, HIV/AIDS, and pancreatic cancer and up to \$5,000 in the area of neoplastic diseases for small research projects.

American Association of Family & Consumer Sciences National Graduate Fellowship

January 9, 2017

Graduate fellowships for individuals who have exhibited the potential to make contributions to the family and consumer sciences profession. The field of family and consumer sciences encompasses the study of relationships among people and their personal environments in order to strengthen communities and advance the well-being of individuals and families over their lifespan.

Leaky Foundation Research Grants

January 10, 2017

Advanced doctoral students whose research is relevant to human origins and evolution may apply for awards between \$3,000 and \$15,000.

Doris Duke International Clinical Research Fellowship

January 10, 2017

Provides an opportunity for up to three US medical students with at least two years of medical school training to complete a yearlong international clinical research project in one of four locations: India, Kenya, Peru, or Tanzania.

Inter-American Foundation Ph.D. Grassroots Development Fellowship

January 11, 2017

Fellowships for currently registered students who have advanced to candidacy for the Ph.D. in social sciences, physical sciences, technical fields, and the professions related to grassroots development issues. Fellowships provide support for field research in independent countries in Latin America or the Caribbean, except for Cuba.

Graduate Women in Science (GWIS) National Fellowships Program

January 13, 2017

The GWIS National Fellowships Program is proud to offer fellowships to help increase knowledge in the fundamental sciences and to encourage research careers in the sciences by women. Endowment funds, mostly generated from bequests, provide the annual income that supports scientific research done by award winners.

Economic History Association Doctoral and Postdoctoral Grants and Fellowships

January 15, 2017

Grants support graduate and postdoctoral research on every phase of economic history, broadly defined.

U.S. Army Center of Military History (CMH) - Dissertation Fellowships

January 15, 2017

Dissertation Fellowships support scholarly research and writing among qualified civilian graduate students preparing dissertations in the history of warfare.

Link Foundation Modeling, Simulation & Training Fellowships

January 15, 2017

To foster advanced level research in modeling, simulation, and training; to enable Ph.D. students the freedom to work on their research full time; and to disseminate research through conferences, journals, & other publications.

Predoctoral Fellowship in Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services

January 15, 2017

Fellowship to support the training of practitioners in behavioral health services and prevention. Designed for students in clinical, counseling and school psychology, and other psychology doctoral students whose training prepares them for careers in behavioral health services. Minorities are especially encouraged to apply.

American Antiquarian Society Short-Term Visiting Academic Research Fellowships

January 15, 2017

Short-term fellowships for one to three months to allow scholars to visit the National Research Library. Various fellowships available to research American history, literature, and/or culture through 1876.

Joan and Stanford Alexander Award

January 15, 2017

Two grants of \$5,000 each for doctoral candidates working on dissertations that concentrate on photography.

Mary Isabel Sibley Fellowship

January 15, 2017

Awarded alternately in the fields of Greek and French. Must be unmarried woman 25-35 years of age who has completed all doctoral requirements except the dissertation.

Hurst Review/American Association of Colleges of Nursing Scholarship

January 15, 2017

Scholarships for students pursuing professional nursing degrees.

U.S. Department of Education EdSim Challenge

January 17, 2017

The U.S. Department of Education calls for concepts for immersive simulations that transfer academic, technical, and employability skills. Successful simulations will pair the engagement of commercial games with rigorous education content to prepare students for the 21st century workforce.

Department of Energy Computational Science Graduate Fellowship

January 18, 2017

First year graduate students in engineering, mathematics, or the physical, computer, or life sciences are eligible to apply. The DOE has a special interest in encouraging the development of the next generation of scientists and engineers who can lead the application of high performance computing to problems in their disciplinary areas.

Dennis Weatherstone Pre-doctoral Fellowship Program

January 18, 2017 by 8 PM

Two-year fellowship for students interested in pursuing careers in autism research. The program honors the late financier Sir Dennis Weatherstone and his commitment to the education of young scientists pursuing autism research. AAMFT Minority Fellowship Program

January 20, 2017 (anticipated)

Doctoral Fellowship: Fellowship for doctoral students enrolled in a Marriage and Family Therapy doctoral program interested in service provision to the nation's youth.

Dissertation Completion Fellowship: Fellowship for doctoral students enrolled in a Marriage and Family Therapy doctoral program who have completed all required pre-dissertation core courses.

American College of Sports Medicine Research Grants and Awards

January 20, 2017

Dr. Raymond A. Weiss Research Endowment: Established for ACSM students studying exercise science. One project will be funded for applied research, with the intent of applying the results to programs involving physical activity and sports.

ACSM Foundation Doctoral Student Research Grant: Research grants for doctoral students up to \$5,000 for a one-year period. The awards are to be used for experimental subjects, supplies, and small equipment needs.

Carl V. Gisolfi Memorial Fund: Grant designated to encourage research in thermoregulation, exercise, and hydration. In support of the mission to increase diversity at ACSM, special consideration is given to minority applicants and proposals addressing minority health issues.

NASA Space Physiology Research Grant: Grant for doctoral students researching in the area of exercise, weightlessness, and musculoskeletal physiology.

Parkinson's Disease Foundation Summer Student Fellowship

January 23, 2017

Fellows work under the close supervision of a sponsor who is an expert in the Parkinson's community and oversees the project.

Intercollegiate Studies Institute Graduate Fellowships

January 23, 2017

Supports the study of students who intend to use their advanced degree to teach or pursue graduate work related to the American founding.

NOAA Fisheries/Sea Grant Graduate Fellowship

January 27, 2017

Center for Retirement Research at Boston College Dissertation Fellowship Program

January 31, 2017

The program is funded by the U.S. Social Security Administration and provides funding opportunities for doctoral candidates to pursue cutting-edge research on retirement income issues.

Harry Frank Guggenheim Dissertation Fellowships

February 1, 2017
