Sigma Delta Pi Graduate Research Grant

March 1, 2017

Research grants for active members of Sigma Delta Pi to travel to Spain and Spanish America for research related to Hispanic Studies.

Dissertation Fellowships in Early American Economy & Society

March 1, 2017

One dissertation research fellowship and four one-month fellowships for research of the American economy and society, from its colonial beginnings to the 1850s. Possible topics include global trade, internal development, politics, the relationship between race/gender and economic forces, and capitalism. Awards provide support for research in residence at The Library Company of Philadelphia.

American Philosophical Society Library Short-Term Resident Research Fellowships

March 1, 2017

Short-term residential fellowships for conducting research in the American Philosophical Society Library.

Sir John Soane's Museum Foundation Traveling Fellowship Program

March 1, 2017

\$5,000 fellowships support travel to London to pursue research projects related to the Sir John Soane's Museum or its collections.

Arena Stage Allen Lee Hughes Fellowship and Internship Program

March 3, 2017

Program is designed to cultivate the next generation of theater professionals by providing the highest standard of training through immersion in the art and business of producing theater.

NASW Foundation Social Work HEALS Policy Fellowship

March 8, 2017

One-year fellowship through the National Association of Social Workers to social workers who have completed at least two years of a doctoral program. Fellows will participate in a social work specific opportunity to use their social work knowledge and research experience to work in Washington, D.C. on critical health policy issues facing our nation.

Universität Kassel International Summer University Scholarships

March 12, 2017

Scholarships available for a graduate student who wishes to take part in the Nano Science module of the International Summer University at Kassel in 2017.

Gerald R. Ford Presidential Foundation Research Travel Grants

March 15, 2017

Grants up to \$2,200 in support of research in the holdings of the Gerald R. Ford Library in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The grant may be used to defray travel costs and living expenses.

American School of Classical Studies at Athens Fellowships and Grants

March 15, 2017

One-year and short-term fellowships to travel to and study at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens

Harry S. Truman Library Research Grant

April 1, 2017

Research Grants of up to \$2,500 are awarded twice annually to offset the cost of conducting research at the Harry S. Truman Library and Museum.

Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey Fellowships

April 7, 2017; October 7, 2017 (anticipated)

Fellowships for international PhD students to pursue their research in Turkey. The program aims to promote Turkey's scientific and technological collaboration with countries of the prospective researchers.

American Jewish Historical Society

Sid and Ruth Lapidus Fellowship

April 20, 2017

Supports one or more researcher(s) wishing to use the collections of the American Jewish Historical Society. Preference is given to researchers interested in 17th and 18th century American Jewish history. At the discretion of the awards committee, the fellowship funds may also be applied to subsidizing publication of a first book in the field of American Jewish history, again with preference given to works in early American Jewish history. The available amount for the award(s) is \$6,000 annually.

Ruth B. Fein Prize

April 20, 2017

A travel stipend established in honor of a past president of the Society, to a graduate student to help undertake research at the American Jewish Historical Society. The award is up to \$1,000.

Tampa Bay Seminole Club Graduate Student Scholarship

April 30, 2017 (anticipated)

It is the goal of the Tampa Bay Seminole club to continue our commitment towards further building a pipeline between Hillsborough and Pasco county high schools and Florida State University. Candidates must be a graduate of a Hillsborough or Pasco county high school and have proof of acceptance into a graduate program at FSU or graduate coursework completed.

The Wenner-Gren Foundation Dissertation Fieldwork Grants

May 1, 2017

Awarded to aid doctoral or thesis research. The program contributes to the Foundation's overall mission to support basic research in anthropology and to ensure that the discipline continues to provide significant work that furthers our understanding of humanity's cultural and biological origins, development, and variation.

Rockefeller Foundation—Bellagio Center Fellowships in the Creative Arts

May 1, 2017

The Academic Writing residency is for university and think tank-based academics, researchers, professors, and scientists working in any discipline. Successful applicants will demonstrate decades of significant professional contributions to their field or show evidence of being on a strong upward trajectory for those earlier in their careers

Society for Male Reproduction and Urology Traveling Scholars Award Program

May 4, 2017 (anticipated)

The objective of this award is to provide an opportunity for trainees to learn more about the field of male infertility by attending educational activities at the annual meeting of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine.

Society for the History of Technology Travel Grant

May 10, 2017 (anticipated)

Designed to defray some costs associated with attending the SHOT conference the grant is open to individuals giving a paper at the annual meeting. The reviewing committee prioritizes scholars whose presentations address women, gender, race, ethnicity, and/or difference in the history of technology. Women, minorities, international scholars, and those who are new to SHOT, are particularly encouraged to apply.

Fulbright—Hays Doctoral Dissertation Research Abroad Program

May 14, 2017

Funds for individual doctoral students who conduct research in other countries, in modern foreign languages and area studies for periods of six to 12 months.

The Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History Fellowship

May 15, 2017

Fellows may conduct research within the archival holdings of any institution located in the five boroughs of New York City.

Luso-American Development Foundation (FLAD) Grant

May 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Short-term research grants to provide researchers with a fruitful stay in Portugal, supplying them with the required means to develop their work, and providing for their travelling and accommodation expenses.

Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM) Student Travel Awards

Deadline: Seven months before the first day of the conference for which support is requested.

Travel awards to help students attend and present at SIAM conferences.

Institute for Humane Studies Conference and Research Grant

Deadline: Rolling, at least four weeks before activity for which you are seeking funding

Grants awarded to graduate students advancing the principles of freedom through their career to present at academic or professional conferences, travel to academic job interviews on a campus or at a conference, travel to archives or libraries for research, and participate in career-development seminars.

The Center for Jewish History Steinberg Fund for Emerging Jewish Filmmakers

Deadline: Rolling

Funding for projects whose subject matter is in line with the collections housed at the Center for Jewish History and who plan to do research at the Center's archives in New York. The goal of this fellowship is to provide small stipends to emerging filmmakers working on topics related to modern Jewish history and is not limited to film students.

American Society for Theater Research Fellowship

March 2017 (anticipated)

Funding to underwrite some of the research expenses of scholars undertaking projects significant to the field of theatre and/or performance studies. Must have been a member of ASTR for 3 of the last 5 years.

American Library Association Miriam L. Hornback Scholarship

March 1, 2017

Annual scholarship to an ALA or library support staffer who is a U.S./Canadian citizen or permanent resident who is pursuing an MLS in an ALA-accredited program.

Neotropical Grassland Conservancy (NGC) Student Grant Program (SGP)

March 1, 2017

Foundation's mission is promoting the conservation of savannas, gallery forests, wetlands, and associated ecosystems in Central and South America. The SGP supports graduate research projects that are often hindered by lack of funds for basic needs such as transportation, lodging, meals & consumable field supplies.

James Madison Graduate Fellowships

March 1, 2017

Fellowships to individuals desiring to become a teacher of American history, American government, or social studies at the secondary school level.

Florida Gubernatorial Fellows Program

March 1, 2017

Non-partisan program immerses students from public and private universities in key areas of state government.

National Association of Social Workers Foundation Fellowships and Scholarships

March 1, 2016

Consuelo W. Gosnell Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to master's degree candidates who have demonstrated a commitment to working with, or who have special affinity with, American Indian/Alaska Native & Hispanic/Latino populations, or in public & voluntary nonprofit agency settings.

Verne LaMarr Lyons Scholarship: Grant awarded to master's degree candidates in social work who demonstrate an interest in, or have experience with, health/mental health practice and a commitment to working in African American communities.

Giva, Inc. Scholarships and Awards

Semi-Annual Excellence in Medicine Student Scholarship

March 1, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students currently enrolled in a school of medicine in the U.S. or Canada.

Semi-Annual Outstanding Nursing Student Scholarship

March 2, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students currently enrolled in an accredited nursing program in the U.S. or Canada.

Academy of Motion Arts and Sciences Nicholl Fellowships in Screenwriting

March 7, April 10, and May 1, 2017

Up to five fellowships for promising new writers. Fellows are expected to complete a feature-length screenplay during the fellowship year.

Education for Sustainable Energy Development Scholarship

March 10, 2017

Support for outstanding international students (citizens of the developing countries and territories identified on the website) pursuing advanced studies in sustainable energy development.

National Strength and Conditioning Association Grants and Scholarships

March 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Grants and Scholarships for students researching questions related to strength training and/or conditioning.

Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation Scholarships

March 18, 2017

Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$10,000 for research in nutrition and dietetics.

Communicative Disorders Scholarship

March 30, 2017

Scholarship for graduate students in audiology or speech-language pathology.

International Furnishings and Design Association Scholarships

March 31, 2017

Vercille Voss IFDA Graduate Student Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students. Must have already completed four design courses at the graduate level.

Ruth Clark Furniture Design Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students whose emphasis is on residential furniture design.

Davis-Putter Scholarship Fund

April 1, 2017

Need-based funding for graduate students who are actively working for peace and justice.

Florida-China Linkage Program

April 1, 2017

Offers tuition exemption for citizens of China.

Space Medicine Association (SMA) Jeffrey R. Davis Scholarship

April 1, 2017

The purpose of the SMA Scholarship is to encourage students, who have demonstrated academic achievement and shown an interest in Space Biology and Space Medical Operations to further pursue a career in Space Medicine. Eligibility: Scholarships are open to students who will be enrolled full-time in college, medical school, residency, or a fellowship during the period of the award and are in good academic standing.

Florida Space Grant Fellowships

April 7, 2017

Master's Fellowship Program: Stipend of \$10,000 for full-time master's students.

Dissertation and Thesis Improvement Fellowship: Up to \$5,000 in supplement funds for items not normally available from the student's university or other sources. Can be used to support a master's thesis or a doctoral dissertation.

Department of Transportation Dwight D. Eisenhower Transportation Fellowship Program Graduate Fellowship

April 14, 2017 (anticipated)

Provides funding for the pursuit of Masters or Doctorate Degrees in transportation related discipline. The Eisenhower Graduate Fellowship Program encompasses all modes of transportation.

ORISE Evaluation Fellowship Opportunity at the CDC

April 14, 2017

Fellows work under the leadership of the CDC's chief Evaluation Officer; they are matched with CDC host programs to work on program evaluation activities for/with those programs. Host programs are selected through a competitive process to ensure the activities build the knowledge base of the program and enhance the professional development of the Fellow.

German-Canadian Studies Fellowship Competition

April 15, 2017

It is awarded on an annual basis for the most promising Master's thesis project in German- Canadian history by a student enrolled in the Universities of Winnipeg and Manitoba's Joint Master's Program in History, working under the supervision of the Chair in German-Canadian Studies at the University of Winnipeg.

Mary Murphy Graduate Scholarship

April 15, 2017

Honors a Delta Sigma Theta Sorority chapter member who placed great value on education and community service. This scholarship was established for professional women who follow Mary Murphy's example.

Arthur C. Pike Scholarship in Meteorology

April 15, 2017

A scholarship from the National Weather Association for students majoring in meteorology.

International Federation for Ethical Research Graduate Fellowship Program for Alternatives to the Use of Animals in Science

April 29, 2017 (anticipated)

The purpose of IFER's Fellowship Program is to provide financial incentives to graduate students in science that encourage them at the earliest stages of their career to integrate innovation and discovery with ethics and respect for animals.

Student Leadership Awards

April 30, 2017

Sponsored by HENAAC, \$1,000 scholarship for STEM graduate students of Hispanic decent that demonstrates leadership excellence.

American Planning Association Judith McManus Price Scholarship

April 30, 2017

Support for women and minority students enrolled in an approved planning program who are U.S. citizens, intend to pursue careers as practicing planners in the public sector, and are able to demonstrate a genuine financial need.

American Society of Interior Designers Scholarships and Awards

April 2017 (anticipated)

Irene Winifred Eno Grant: Funding for work that is dedicated to health, safety, and welfare.

Legacy Scholarship for Graduate Students: Scholarships for graduate students in interior design.

Foundation for Community Association Research Byron Hanke Fellowship

May 1, 2017

Fellowship is available to graduate students working on topics related to community associations. Fellows are expected to prepare a research paper on community associations.

American Nurses Foundation Research Grants

May 1, 2017 (anticipated)

The American Nurses Foundation Nursing Research Grants Program encourages the research career development of all nurses by providing funds to beginning and experienced nurse researchers to conduct studies that contribute toward the advancement of nursing science and the enhancement of patient outcomes. Awards are given in all areas of nursing, including healthy patient outcomes, health care policy development, critical care, gerontology, women's health, child health, community and family intervention, and leadership.

American Hotel and Lodging Educational Fund Graduate Scholarship

May 1, 2017

The program is open to hospitality management graduate students as well as graduate students who have an undergraduate hospitality management degree or at least four years' employment in the industry.

American Association of Colleges of Nursing Minority Nurse Faculty Scholarship

May 1, 2017

Support to graduate nursing students from minority backgrounds who agree to teach in a school of nursing after graduation.

IEEE Life Members Graduate Study Fellowship in Electrical Engineering

May 2, 2017

Award for first year, full-time graduate student for work in electrical engineering.

Clara Mayo Grants

May 15, 2017

This program was set up to support masters' theses or pre-dissertation research on aspects of sexism, racism, or prejudice, with preference given to students enrolled in a terminal master's program. Studies of the application of theory or the design of interventions or treatments to address these problems are welcome.

Richard A. Horovitz Fund for African Artists and Scholars in the Humanities and Social Sciences

May 15, 2017

Dedicated to African artists and scholars in the humanities and social sciences that are citizens of a Sub-Saharan African country. Graduate students, researchers or artists in a program at an accredited U.S. university, cultural or artistic institution (on a F or J visa).

American Speech-Language-Hearing Foundation Graduate Student Scholarships

May 23, 2017 (anticipated)

Scholarships for full-time students who will be or who are currently enrolled in a graduate program in communication science and disorders.

Florida House of Representatives Legislative Intern Program

May 31, 2017 (anticipated)

Intern program for graduate students that places them in various offices in the Florida House of Representatives, giving students legislative and policy experience working on projects, bills, amendments, and analysis. The internship pays a stipend and tuition.

Philanthropic Educational Organization (P.E.O.) Program for Continuing Education

Deadline: 3-4 months prior to the start of the term for which the grant is requested

One-time need based grants to women who are citizens or legal permanent residents of the U.S. or Canada for use in completing a degree or certification necessary for improving or gaining skills leading to employment.

American Psychological Foundation Esther Katz Rosen Fund Grants

March 1, 2017

Support will be provided for activities on the advancement and application of knowledge related to identify gifted and talented children and adolescents.

American Society of Criminology Ruth D. Peterson Fellowship for Racial and Ethnic Diversity

March 1, 2017

Designed to encourage students of color, especially those from racial and ethnic groups underrepresented in the field, to enter the field of criminology and criminal justice, and to facilitate the completion of their degrees.

Giva, Inc. Scholarships and Awards

Semi-Annual Excellence in Medicine Student Scholarship

March 1, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students currently enrolled in a school of medicine in the U.S. or Canada.

Doctoral (Continued)

Semi-Annual Outstanding Nursing Student Scholarship

March 2, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for students in an accredited nursing program in the U.S. or Canada.

Dissertation Grant in Cold War History

March 3, 2017

\$3,000 grant to a graduate student in history or related fields working on a dissertation in the area of Cold War military history. Proposals are welcome in all subject areas, including international security affairs, military strategy, leadership, and operations.

National Association of Social Workers Foundation Eileen Blackey Doctoral Fellowship

March 8, 2017

Fellowship for social work doctoral candidates who are engaged in dissertation research in welfare policy and practice.

IHR Dissertation Fellowships

March 10, 2017

The applications will be evaluated for academic excellence, as well as the likelihood of completion according to the proposed schedule.

Fulbright—Hays Doctoral Dissertation Research Abroad Program

March 14, 2017

Funds for individual doctoral students who conduct research in other countries, in modern foreign languages and area studies for periods of six to 12 months.

Beta Phi Mu Eugene Garfield Doctoral Dissertation Fellowship

March 15, 2017

Awards for doctoral students who are working on their dissertations in Library and Information Science, Information Studies, Informatics, or a related field.

National Strength and Conditioning Association Grants and Scholarships

March 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Grants and Scholarships for students researching questions related to strength training and/or conditioning.

Israel Institute Doctoral Fellowship

March 15, 2017

Two-year fellowships open to both doctoral students who are working on Israel as a primary topic of research and also to candidates whose focus is broader but whose work incorporates an Israeli dimension.

The Kevy Kaiserman Memorial Grant

March 15, 2017

Summer fellowships from the Myer and Rosaline Feinstein Center for American and Jewish History of up to \$3,000 to support research in the American Jewish experience.

Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation Scholarships

March 18, 2017

Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$10,000 for research in nutrition and dietetics.

Health Policy Research Scholars

March 29, 2017

Opportunity for full-time doctoral students from underrepresented populations or historically disadvantaged backgrounds interested in health policy research. Program selects up to 50 first or second year doctoral scholars pursuing research focused degrees in disciplines that can advance a Culture of Health.

Communicative Disorders Scholarship

March 30, 2017

Scholarship for graduate students in audiology or speech-language pathology.

Association for the Study of the Middle East and Africa Research Grants Program

March 31, 2017

Grants up to \$2,500 to support study of the Middle East and Africa. Applicants must be ASMEA members and enrolled in a Ph.D. program. Recipients will be required to present their research at the annual ASMEA conference in Washington, D.C.

International Furnishings and Design Association Scholarships

March 31, 2017

Vercille Voss IFDA Graduate Student Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students. Must have already completed four design courses at the graduate level.

Ruth Clark Furniture Design Scholarship: Funding for graduate-level interior design students whose emphasis is on residential furniture design.

Botstiber Fellowship in Austrian-American Studies

March 31, 2017

The fellowship will be awarded to a scholar or professional who seeks funds for a project that promotes an understanding of the historic relationship between Austria and the United States. A grant of up to \$30,000 will be considered for support for salary, travel, or other necessary expenses.

Institute for Supply Management Doctoral Dissertation Grant Program

March 31, 2017

Sociologists for Women in Society

April 1, 2017

Barbara Rosenblum Cancer Dissertation Scholarship: Scholarship is designed to encourage doctoral research on women's experience of breast cancer and other reproductive cancers, as well as the prevention of these cancers. The scholarship also supports efforts to make sociological research on these topics available to the public.

Beth B. Hess Memorial Scholarship: Scholarship is awarded to a dissertation writing PhD student who has studied for at least one full academic year at a two-year college in the U.S., before transferring to complete a BA.

Cheryl Allyn Miller Award: Award recognizes a sociology graduate student, or a recent doctorate, whose research or activism constitutes an outstanding contribution to the field of women and work.

Esther Ling Nang Chow and Mary Joyce Green Dissertation Scholarship: Scholarship offers support to women scholars who are from underrepresented groups and are studying concerns that women of color face domestically and/or internationally.

American Musicological Society (AMS)

April 1, 2017

M. Elizabeth C. Bartlet Fund: A memorial to M. Elizabeth C. Bartlet, one of the foremost scholars of French music from the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. It is to be awarded annually to one or more doctoral students at or graduates of universities in the United States and Canada to conduct doctoral or post-doctoral musicological research in France.

Virginia and George Bozarth Travel Fund: intended to encourage and assist Ph.D. candidates, post-doctoral scholars, independent scholars, and junior faculty to travel to Austria to carry out research.

William Holmes / Frank D'Accone Endowment: The Holmes / D'Accone Endowment encourages and assists Ph.D. candidates, postdoctoral fellows, independent scholars, and junior faculty working with subject matter associated with the history of opera.

Jan LaRue Travel Fund: The fund honors the memory of Jan LaRue (1918–2004), a distinguished scholar and AMS member admired for his pioneering work on style analysis, the eighteenth-century symphony, and early computer applications in musicology.

Harold Powers World Travel Fund: The fund is intended to encourage and assist Ph.D. candidates, in all fields of musical scholarship to travel anywhere in the world to carry out the necessary work for their dissertation or other research.

Doctoral Dissertation Grant Program (Fahs-Beck Scholars)

April 1, 2017

Grants up to \$5000 to help support dissertation expenses of doctoral students whose studies have the potential for adding significantly to knowledge about problems in the functioning or well-being of children, adults, couples, families, or communities, or about interventions designed to prevent or alleviate such problems.

Davis-Putter Scholarship Fund

April 1, 2017

Need-based funding for graduate students who are actively working for peace and justice.

Society for Historians of American Foreign Relations Dissertation Completion Fellowship

April 1, 2017

SHAFR will make two, year-long awards in the amount of \$25,000 each to support the writing and completion of the doctoral dissertation. Applicants should be working on a topic in the field of U.S. foreign relations history or international history, and must be current members of SHAFR.

American Institute of Afghanistan Studies John F. Richards Fellowship Program

April 1, 2017

Invites applications for support of short-term research or other scholarly projects that will advance the knowledge of Afghanistan. The Institute will be accepting applications for proposed projects along two tiers of the John F. Richards Fellowship Program. The program includes two different types of fellowships. Applicants must be individual members of AIAS to apply. Applicants for the Research Fellowship must be U.S. Citizens and be predoctoral, postdoctoral, junior, or senior scholars.

North American Conference on Business Studies Dissertation Fellowship

April 1, 2017

Supports dissertation research in the British Isles on any topic of British (including Scottish, Irish and Imperial) history or British Studies. Applicant must need to travel to the British Isles for the purpose of dissertation research.

The NASA Fellowship in the History of Space Technology

April 1, 2017

This fellowship will fund one pre-doctoral fellow for up to one academic year to undertake a research project related to the history of space technology including cultural and intellectual history, institutional history, economic history, history of law and public policy and history of engineering and management.

Florida-China Linkage Program

April 1, 2017

Offers tuition exemption for citizens of China.

History of Science Society Fellowship in the History of Space Science

April 1, 2017

The fellowship, offered by the History of Science Society and supported by the NASA History Division will annually fund one Fellow, for up to one academic year, to undertake a research project related to the history of space science. The HSS Fellowship in the History of Space Science is intended to fund research in the history of space science broadly conceived, including its social, cultural, institutional and personal context.

Department of Transportation Dwight D. Eisenhower Transportation Fellowship Program Graduate Fellowship

April 14, 2017 (anticipated)

Provides funding for the pursuit of Masters or Doctorate Degrees in transportation related discipline. The Eisenhower Graduate Fellowship Program encompasses all modes of transportation.

May 15, 2017 (anticipated; contact OFGA for application materials)

Dedicated to African artists and scholars that are citizens of a Sub-Saharan African country. The winners receive an award to defray educational costs for one academic year, renewable for a second year based on satisfactory academic performance and continued need.

ACRP: Graduate Research Award Program on Public-Sector Aviation Issues

May 15, 2017

Stipend for graduate students researching airport and related aviation system issues. The program is intended to stimulate thought, discussion, and research by those who may become the future airport managers, operators, designers, and policy makers in aviation.

Laurels Fund

May 15, 2017

This fund provides one year scholarships, ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 each, for women who are pursuing a Ph.D. degree in Accounting.
