Awarded to aid doctoral or thesis research. The program contributes to the Foundation's overall mission to support basic research in anthropology and to ensure that the discipline continues to provide significant work that furthers our understanding of humanity's cultural and biological origins, development, and variation.

Rockefeller Foundation—Bellagio Center Fellowships in the Creative Arts

May 1, 2017

The Academic Writing residency is for university and think tank-based academics, researchers, professors, and scientists working in any discipline. Successful applicants will demonstrate decades of significant professional contributions to their field or show evidence of being on a strong upward trajectory.

Society for Male Reproduction and Urology Traveling Scholars Award Program

May 4, 2017

The objective of this award is to provide an opportunity for trainees to learn more about the field of male infertility by attending educational activities at the annual meeting of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine.

Society for the History of Technology Travel Grant

May 10, 2017 (anticipated)

Designed to defray some costs associated with attending the SHOT conference the grant is open to individuals giving a paper at the annual meeting. The reviewing committee prioritizes scholars whose presentations address women, gender, race, ethnicity, and/or difference in the history of technology. Women, minorities, international scholars, and those who are new to SHOT, are particularly encouraged to apply.

The Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History Fellowship

Fellows may conduct research within the archival holdings of any institution located in the five boroughs of New York City.

Luso-American Development Foundation (FLAD) Grant

May 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Short-term research grants to provide researchers with a fruitful stay in Portugal, supplying them with the required means to develop their work, and providing for their travelling and accommodation expenses.

Golden Key Awards

June 15, 2017

Research Grant

Supports members' research and/or presentation of research at conferences.

Joan Nelson Study Abroad Scholarship

Assists members who are going to participate in a study abroad program.

American Institute of Indian Studies Junior Research Fellowships

July 1, 2017

Research fellowships to enable doctoral candidates to pursue their dissertation research in India.

Wolf Trap Internships

July 1, 2017

Spring, Summer, and Fall internships available to foster the next generation of arts leaders. 12-week program with flexible start and end dates in Washington, DC.

National Museum of the American Indian Internship Program

July 12, 2017

Internships are provided for students interested in the museum profession and related fields. Locations are in Maryland, Washington D.C. or New York for a duration of 10 weeks.

Americans for the Arts—Internship Opportunities

July 17, 2017

The Internship Program offers undergraduate and graduate students the opportunity to investigate and participate in the operations of the nation's leading nonprofit for advancing the arts in America. Fall, Winter/Spring, and Summer Internships are available.

University Research Association Visiting Scholars Program

August 28, 2017

Funding for visits to work at Fermilab for up to one year. Support provided by the program may include travel and local lodging expenses during a series of short visits or salary support and round trip travel expenses for an extended visit.

Christine Mirzayan Science and Technology Policy Graduate Fellowship Program

September 6, 2017 (anticipated)

Spend 12 weeks at the National Academies in Washington, DC, learning about science and technology policy and the role that scientists and engineers play in advising the nation. Applicants become part of a National Academies committee, board, or unit where they are assigned to a mentor and learn about the world of science and technology policy.

Travel (Continued)

Mid Atlantic Arts Foundation USArtists International Grants

September 7, 2017 (anticipated)

Funding for American artists to perform at important cultural festivals and art marketplaces around the globe.

German Chancellor Fellowship for Prospective Leaders

September 15, 2017

Conduct independent projects at a host institution in Germany for one year, network with other prospective leaders from abroad and explore new solutions to the global issues of our times.

Women Chemists Committee/Eli Lilly Travel Awards

September 15, 2017

Need-based grants offered to graduate and postdoctoral women chemists to travel and present the results of their research at scientific meetings.

Gerald R. Ford Presidential Foundation Research Travel Grants

September 15, 2017

Grants up to \$2,200 in support of research in the holdings of the Gerald R. Ford Library. The grant may be used to defray travel costs and living expenses.

Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM) Student Travel Awards

Deadline: Seven months before the first day of the conference for which support is requested. Travel awards to help students attend and present at SIAM conferences.

Institute for Humane Studies Conference and Research Grant

Deadline: Rolling, at least four weeks before activity for which you are seeking funding Grants awarded to graduate students advancing the principles of freedom through their career to present at academic or professional conferences, travel to academic job interviews on a campus or at a conference, travel to archives or libraries for research, and participate in career-development seminars.

The Center for Jewish History Steinberg Fund for Emerging Jewish Filmmakers

Deadline: Rolling

Funding for projects whose subject matter is in line with collections housed at the Center for Jewish History and who plan to do research at the Center's New York archives. The fellowship provides small stipends to emerging filmmakers working on topics related to modern Jewish history and is not limited to film students.



Foundation for Community Association Research Byron Hanke Fellowship

May 1, 2017

Fellowship is available to graduate students working on topics related to community associations. Fellows are expected to prepare a research paper on community associations.

American Nurses Foundation Research Grants

May 1, 2017

The American Nurses Foundation Nursing Research Grants Program encourages the research career development of all nurses by providing funds to beginning and experienced nurse researchers to conduct studies that contribute toward the advancement of nursing science and the enhancement of patient outcomes. Awards are given in all areas of nursing, including healthy patient outcomes, health care policy development, critical care, gerontology, women's health, child health, community and family intervention, and leadership.

American Hotel and Lodging Educational Fund Graduate Scholarship

May 1, 2017

The program is open to hospitality management graduate students as well as graduate students who have an undergraduate hospitality management degree or at least four years' employment in the industry.

American Association of Colleges of Nursing Minority Nurse Faculty Scholarship

May 1, 2017

Support to graduate nursing students from minority backgrounds who agree to teach in a school of nursing after graduation.

IEEE Life Members Graduate Study Fellowship in Electrical Engineering

May 2, 2017

Award for first year, full-time graduate student for work in electrical engineering.

Mozilla Graduate Fellowships in Open Source and Data Sharing in the Life/Natural Sciences

May 14, 2017

Researchers working to shift research practice to be more collaborative, iterative and open. Fellows remain at their home institution but receive training and support from Mozilla to hone their skills around open source and data sharing.

Master's (Continued)

Clara Mayo Grants

May 15, 2017

This program was set up to support masters' theses or pre-dissertation research on aspects of sexism, racism, or prejudice, with preference given to students enrolled in a terminal master's program. Studies of the application of theory or the design of interventions or treatments to address these problems are welcome.

Richard A. Horovitz Fund for African Artists and Scholars in the Humanities and Social Sciences

May 15, 2017

Dedicated to African artists and scholars in the humanities and social sciences that are citizens of a Sub-Saharan African country. Graduate students, researchers or artists in a program at an accredited U.S. university, cultural or artistic institution (on a F or J visa).

NCAA Graduate Student Research Grant

May 15, 2017

Research grants for students conducting research within the general topic areas of student-athlete psychosocial well-bring and college athletics participation.

Florida Outdoor Writers Association Scholarship

May 19, 2017

FOWA Scholarships are competitive and open to students at Florida colleges and universities, or to any student whose application is endorsed by a FOWA member or a faculty advisor. Up to three scholarships of \$1,000 each are awarded. These scholarships are intended for students whose career goals are to communicate to the public appreciation for hunting, fishing and other aspects of the outdoor experience.

International Federation for Ethical Research Graduate Fellowship Program for Alternatives to the Use of Animals in Science

May 22, 2017

Fellowship program to provide financial incentives to graduate students in science that encourage them at the earliest stages of their career to integrate innovation and discovery with ethics and respect for animals.

American Speech-Language-Hearing Foundtion Graduate Student Scholarships

May 22, 2017

Scholarships for full-time students who will be or who are currently enrolled in a graduate program in communication science and disorders.

Florida House of Representatives Legislative Intern Program

May 31, 2017

Intern program for graduate students that places them in various offices in the Florida House of Representatives, giving students legislative and policy experience working on projects, bills, amendments, and analysis. The internship pays a stipend and tuition.

Giva Semi-Annual Student Scholarship and Worldwide Community Ambassador Award

June 1, 2017

Scholarship toward tuition for any graduate student designed to assist students further their education as well as their social responsibility and community service footprint in the world.

Archives of American Art Fellowships and Internships

June 1, 2017

Multiple internships of at least 10 weeks for students interested in archival science, information management, museum studies, art, administration, art history, and cultural studies.

Florida Nurses Foundation Grants

June 1, 2017

Multiple scholarships and research grants available for nursing students.

Kenneth and Barbara Starks Plant Resistance to Insects Graduate Student Award

June 1, 2017

The award recognizes innovative research by a graduate student in entomology or plant breeding/genetics whose work contributes significantly to knowledge of plant resistance to insects.

Council of Writing Program Administrators Research Grant

June 2, 2017

Funding for research projects that investigate issues and practices in writing program administration. Awards are offered in both a general research category and a targeted research category.

Ecological Society of America Centennial Graduate Student Fellows Program

June 5, 2017

Awards for graduate students interested in fostering public understanding and appreciation of ecological research and in encouraging pre-college students to consider research careers in ecology.

American Foundation for Translation and Interpretation Student Translation Award

June 8, 201

Grant-in-aid to a student for a literary or sci-tech translation or translation-related project. Also includes support for attending ATA's Annual Conference.

Thermo Fisher Scientific Antibody Scholarship Program

June 15, 2017

The scholarship is offered to graduate students in biology, chemistry, biochemistry or a related life science field. The scholarship is for the fall semester.

HORIZONS Scholarship

July 15, 2017 (anticipated)

Scholarships for women interested in pursuing a career related to national security or defense.

NEWH Sunshine Chapter Scholarship

July 15, 2017

Description: Scholarship for students pursuing careers affiliated in the hospitality industry.

Master's (Continued)

Acton Institute for the Study of Religion and Liberty Calihan Academic Fellowship

July 15, 2017

Scholarships and grants for graduate students currently studying theology, philosophy, economics, or related fields must demonstrate the potential to advance understanding in the relationship between theology and the principles of the free and virtuous society. Such principles include recognition of human dignity, the importance of the rule of law, limited government, religious liberty, and freedom in economic life.

Hurst Review/American Association of Colleges of Nursing Scholarship

July 15, 2017

Scholarships for students pursuing professional nursing degrees.

The Noah Greenberg Award

August 15, 2017

The award is intended as a grant-in-aid to stimulate active cooperation between scholars and performers by recognizing and fostering outstanding contributions to historical performing practices.

Paul Farmer Global Surgery Fellowship Research Fellowship

August 15, 2017

One- and two-year fellowships to further promote surgical care, education, and research pertinent to global surgery.

Pediatric Endocrinology Nursing Society Academic Education Scholarship

September 1, 2017

One-time need based grants to women who are citizens or legal permanent residents of the U.S. or Canada for use in completing a degree or certification necessary for improving or gaining skills leading to employment.



Paul A. Volcker Endowment for Public Service Research & Education Junior Scholar Research Grant Program

May 1, 2017 (anticipated)

The APSA Organized Section for Public Administration invites applications and research proposals from junior scholars researching public administration issues affecting governance in the United States and abroad. Proposals will be judged on their potential to shed new light on important public administration questions, their scholarly and methodological rigor, and their promise for advancing practice and theory development.

American Association of Colleges of Nursing Minority Nurse Faculty Scholarship

May 1, 2017

Support to graduate nursing students from minority backgrounds who agree to teach in a school of nursing after graduation.

American Marketing Association Foundation Valuing Diversity Ph.D. Scholarships May 1, 2017

The American Marketing Association Foundation (AMAF), in conjunction with the AMA Academic Council, established a scholarship program in 2003 focused on creating scholarship funds for populations underrepresented in the marketing profession.

General Lemuel C. Shepherd, Jr., Memorial Dissertation Fellowship

May 1, 2017

A \$10,000 dissertation fellowship. Topics in U.S. military and naval history, as well as history and history-based studies in the social and behavioral sciences, with a direct relationship to the history of the United States Marine Corps will be considered.

IEEE Life Members Graduate Study Fellowship in Electrical Engineering

Award for students pursing full-time graduate work in electrical engineering.

Scholarships in Waste Management Research and Education

SRCD SECC Dissertation Research Funding Awards

Up to ten, non-renewable awards in the amount of \$2,000 given for dissertation research proposals that merit special recognition and display the strong potential to contribute to the field of child development

Florida Space Grant Dissertation and Thesis Improvement Fellowship

May 12, 2017

Up to \$5,000 in supplement funds for items not normally available from the student's university or other sources. Can be used to support a master's thesis or a doctoral dissertation.

Mozilla Graduate Fellowships in Open Source and Data Sharing in the Life/Natural Sciences

May 14, 2017

Researchers working to shift research practice to be more collaborative, iterative and open. Fellows remain at their home institution but receive training and support from Mozilla to hone their skills around open source and data sharing.

Richard A. Horovitz Fund for African Artists and Scholars in the Humanities and Social Sciences

May 15, 2017 (anticipated; contact OFGA for application materials)

Dedicated to African artists and scholars that are citizens of a Sub-Saharan African country. The winners receive an award to defray educational costs for one academic year, renewable for a second year based on satisfactory academic performance and continued need.

ACRP: Graduate Research Award Program on Public-Sector Aviation Issues

May 15, 2017

Stipend for graduate students researching airport and related aviation system issues. The program is intended to stimulate thought, discussion, and research by those who may become the future airport managers, operators, designers, and policy makers in aviation.

NCAA Graduate Student Research Grant

May 15, 2017

Research grants for students conducting research within the general topic areas of student-athlete psychosocial well-bring and college athletics participation.

Laurels Fund

May 15, 2017

This fund provides one year scholarships, ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 each, for women who are pursuing a Ph.D. degree in Accounting.

July 15, 2017

Description: Scholarship for students pursuing careers affiliated in the hospitality industry.

Military Suicide Research Consortium Dissertation Completion Award

July 29, 2017 (anticipated)

Dissertation completion award for doctoral students whose dissertation director is a current member of the MSRC. The awards are intended to provide necessary support for completion of a doctoral dissertation on a topic of relevance to the Consortium.

Harry Frank Guggenheim Foundation Research Grant

August 1, 2017

Awards given to proposals in the natural and social sciences and the humanities that promise to increase understanding for the causes, manifestations, and control of violence and aggression. Highest priority is given to research that can increase understanding and amelioration of urgent problems of violence and aggression in the modern world.

Clayton Dissertation Proposal Competition

August 8, 2017 (anticipated)

The Alden G. Clayton competition recognizes the best doctoral dissertation proposals on important marketing subjects. This annual competition is named in honor of former MSI president Alden G. Clayton, who retired in 1986 after more than a decade of leadership at the Institute.

NSF Geography and Spatial Sciences Program Doctoral Dissertation Research Improvement Award

August 10, 2017

The Geography and Spatial Sciences Program sponsors research on the geographic distributions and interactions of human, physical, and biotic systems on Earth. Investigators are encouraged to propose plans for research about the nature, causes, and consequences of human activity and natural environmental processes across a range of scales.

Epilepsy Foundation Research Grants Program

August 12, 2017 (anticipated)

Series of grants and fellowships to advance the understanding of epilepsy that will lead to better treatment, more effective prevention, and ultimately to a cure.

NSF Cultural Anthropology Program Doctoral Dissertation Research Improvement Grants

August 15, 2017

August 15, 2017
