Wolf Trap Internships

November 1, 2017; February 1, 2018

Spring, Summer, and Fall internships available to foster the next generation of arts leaders. 12-week program with flexible start and end dates in Washington, DC.

The Wenner-Gren Foundation Dissertation Fieldwork Grants

November 1, 2017

Awarded to aid doctoral or thesis research. The program contributes to the Foundation's overall mission to support basic research in anthropology and to ensure that the discipline continues to provide significant work that furthers our understanding of humanity's cultural and biological origins, development, and variation.

Dumbarton Oaks Research Library and Collection

November 1, 2017

Summer Fellowship

Fellowships for Byzantine, Pre-Columbian, or Garden and Landscape scholars on any level of advancement beyond the first year of graduate (post-baccalaureate) study.

Mellon Fellowships in Urban Landscape Studies

Fellowships for scholars & designers to research the history & current conditions of urban landscapes.

Junior Fellowship

Fellowships for students who have fulfilled all preliminary requirements for the PhD or appropriate final degree and will be working on a dissertation or final project at Dumbarton Oaks under the direction of a faculty member at their own university.

German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)

German Studies Research Grant

November 1, 2017

Specialized DAAD program offers German Studies Research Grants to highly-qualified undergraduate and graduate students who are nominated by their department/program chairs. The grant may be used for short-term research (one to two months) in Germany.

DAAD Long Term Research Grants

November 4, 2017

Long-term research grants are awarded to highly qualified candidates who desire to conduct long-term research (7-10 months) or join a German doctoral program.

Program in China Studies Predissertation-Summer Travel Grants

November 9, 2017

Predissertation—summer travel grants, postdoctoral fellowships as well as collaborative reading-workshop grants available.

Leifur Eiríksson Foundation Scholarship Program

November 15, 2017

For graduate research or study at universities in Iceland. Up to \$25,000 in project costs, including travel to and from the research or study site will be paid on the scholar's behalf.

Critical Language Scholarship Program

November 15, 2017

Part of a U.S. government effort to expand dramatically the number of Americans studying and mastering critical foreign languages. Languages Supported: Azerbaijani, Bangla/Bengali, Hindi, Indonesian, Korean, Punjabi, Swahili, Turkish, Urdu, Arabic, Persian, Chinese, Japanese, and Russian.

National Museum of the American Indian Internship Program

November 20, 2017; February 6, 2018

Internships are provided for students interested in the museum profession and related fields. Locations are in Maryland, Washington D.C. or New York for a duration of 10 weeks.

DOE Office of Science Graduate Student Research (SCGSR) Program

November 21, 2017

Prepares graduate students for science, technology, engineering, or mathematics careers critically important to the DOE Office of Science mission, by providing graduate thesis research opportunities at DOE laboratories.

Kress History of Art: Institutional Fellowship

November 30, 2017

The Kress History of Art: Institutional Fellowships are intended to provide promising young art historians with the opportunity to experience immersion in European art history.

John Carter Brown Library Research Fellowships

December 1, 2017

Supports research at the John Carter Brown Library on the colonial history of the Americas (North and South), including all aspects of the European, African, and Native American involvement.

Neotropical Grassland Conservancy (NGC) Student Grant Program

December 1, 2017

The foundation's mission is promoting the conservation of savannas, gallery forests, wetlands, and associated ecosystems in Central and South America. The Student Grant Program (SGP) was designed in response to feedback from Venezuelan professors. Graduate student research projects are often hindered by lack of funds for basic needs such as transportation, lodging, meals and consumable field supplies. Open to Latin American students enrolled in a M.S. or Ph.D. program in a US or South American university.

Mid Atlantic Arts Foundation US Artists International Grants

December 1, 2017

Funding for American artists to perform at important cultural festivals and art marketplaces around the globe.

RAND Graduate Student Summer Associate Program

December 4, 2017

Program designed to introduce students to RAND, an institution that conducts research on a wide range of national security problems and domestic and international social policy issues. Designed for full-time students who have completed at least two years of graduate work leading to a doctorate or professional degree (e.g., law, medicine, engineering).

Department of Homeland Security HS-STEM Summer Internship Program

December 7, 2017

10-week summer internship in a broad spectrum of research areas for students majoring in homeland security disciplines related to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Provides students with quality research experiences at federal research facilities across the country. Areas of research include engineering, computer science, mathematics, physics, chemistry, biological/life sciences, environmental science, emergency and incident management, social sciences, and more.

Women Techmakers Scholars Program

December 11, 2017

Awards for female graduate students in computer science, computer engineering, or closely related technical field. Includes support for the academic year and participation in the Annual Google Scholars' Retreat.

Carnegie Saharan Crossroads Fellowship Program

December 15, 2017

Saharan Crossroads seeks to counter the conceptual divide separating North and sub-Saharan Africa and the tendency to view the Sahara Desert as an impenetrable barrier dividing the continent into the northern "white" and sub-Saharan "black" Africa.

Qasid Annual Scholarship Program

December 15, 2017

Scholarship to study Arabic at the Qasid Arabic Institute.

KRESS Fellowships for Language Study

December 15, 2017

Fellowships for art history and art conservation graduate students to attend the Middlebury Summer Language Schools in French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Russian, or Spanish.

Association for Education Finance Policy Roe L. Johns Travel Grants

December 31, 2017

Need-based travel grants awarded to graduate students in the area of education finance and policy who present papers at the AEFPP Annual Conference.

Humanity in Action - Summer Graduate Fellowship Program in Diplomacy and Diversity

January 8, 2018

Fellows travel to Amsterdam, Atlanta, Berlin, Copenhagen, Detroit, Sarajevo, or Warsaw to study how American and European governments and societies are responding to a wide range of international issues.

American School of Classical Studies at Athens Fellowships and Grants

January 15, 2018; February 15, 2018

One-year and short-term fellowships to travel to and study at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens.

Economic History Association Doctoral and Postdoctoral Grants and Fellowships

January 15, 2018

Grants support graduate and postdoctoral research on every phase of economic history, broadly defined. Applicants must be members of the Association.

Chateaubriand Fellowship

January 16, 2018

The Chateaubriand Fellowship is a grant offered by the Embassy of France in the United States. Every year, it allows doctoral students enrolled in American universities to conduct research in France for 4 to 9 months. Fellowships are available in STEM and Humanities & Social Sciences fields.

Boren Fellowship

January 30, 2018 (Contact OGFA for Internal Deadline)

Boren Fellowships, an initiative of the National Security Education Program, provide unique funding opportunities for U.S. graduate students to study less commonly taught languages in world regions critical to U.S. interests, and underrepresented in study abroad, including Africa, Asia, Central and Eastern Europe, Eurasia, Latin America, and the Middle East. The countries of Western Europe, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand are excluded.

Catherine H. Beattie Fellowship in Conservation Horticulture

January 31, 2018

Annual research grant for graduate students in biology, horticulture, or a related field to study at a botanical garden.

Council of American Overseas Research Centers

January 31, 2018

Andrew W. Mellon Mediterranean Regional Research Fellowship

The CAORC is pleased to offer a focused regional fellowship program enabling pre- and early postdoctoral scholars to carry out research in the humanities and related social sciences in countries bordering the Mediterranean and served by American overseas research centers. These fellowships foster international scholarship, education and cultural dialogue. Thousands of fellowships are made available each year.

The Multi-Country Research Fellowship

Multi-Country Research Fellowship Program supports advanced regional or trans-regional research in the humanities, social sciences, or allied natural sciences for U.S. doctoral candidates and scholars who have already earned their Ph.D. Preference will be given to candidates examining comparative and/or cross-regional research. Scholars must carry out research for a minimum of 90 days in two or more countries outside the United States, at least one of which hosts a participating American overseas research center.

Students will be selected to participate in ongoing research projects under the supervision of ETS senior staff. The program seeks to increase the number of women and minority professionals in educational measurement and related fields.

Center for Jewish History Graduate Research Fellowship

February 2, 2018

Residential ten-month fellowships for doctoral candidates to support original research using the collections of the Center's partners: American Jewish Historical Society, American Sephardi Federation, Leo Baeck Institute, Yeshiva University Museum, and YIVO, Institute for Jewish Research. Preference is given to those candidates who draw on the library and archival resources of more than one partner institution.

Mathematica Center for Studying Disability Policy

Summer Fellowship in Disability Policy Research

February 10, 2018 (anticipated)

Opportunity for students in master's programs or early in doctoral programs (pre-dissertation phase) to spend the summer of 2018 at Mathematica's Washington, DC office to learn more about conducting an independent research project related to disability policy.

Dissertation Fellowship Program

February 17, 2018 (anticipated)

Fellowship which offers financial support to students conducting their doctoral dissertation research on topics consistent with the DRC's mission. Provides support for graduate students and introduces them to tropical research. These fellowships enable selected candidates to work in the Smithsonian Tropical Research Institute and explore research possibilities at STRI.

Interior Design Educators Council South Region Graduate Student Travel scholarship

February 20, 2018 (anticipated)

Travel reimbursement for students from the south region to attend the IDEC National Conference.

University Research Association Visiting Scholars Program

February 26, 2018

Funding for visits to work at Fermilab for up to one year.

The Mariam K. Chamberlain Fellowship in Women and Public Policy

February 28, 2018 (anticipated)

\$27,000, nine-month fellowships assist in the professional development of students and graduates interested in economic and educational support for women.

Institute for Humane Studies Conference and Research Grant

Deadline: Rolling, at least four weeks before activity for which you are seeking funding

Grants awarded to graduate students advancing the principles of freedom through their career to present at academic or professional conferences, travel to academic job interviews on a campus or at a conference, travel to archives or libraries for research, and participate in career-development seminars.

American Cancer Society Graduate Scholarships in Cancer Nursing

November 1, 2018

Supports graduate students pursuing a master's degree in cancer nursing or doctorate of nursing practice (DNP). Awards may be for two years, with stipend of \$10,000 per year.

Tallahassee Mayoral Fellowship Program

November 6, 2017

Yearlong fellowship for graduate students to engage with key areas of City government and serve in invaluable front-line positions alongside top leaders of City Hall.

Arthur C. Pike Scholarship in Meteorology

November 10, 2017 (anticipated)

A scholarship from the National Weather Association for students majoring in meteorology.

GEM MS Engineering Fellowship Program

November 13, 2017

The objective of this program is to promote the benefits of a master's degree within industry. GEM Fellows are provided practical engineering summer work experiences through an employer sponsor and a portable academic year fellowship of tuition, fees, and a stipend which may be used at any participating GEM Member University where the GEM Fellow is admitted.

Internships with the Middle East Program

The Program concentrates on long-term developments and how such issues impact stability and growth in the region and its relations with the United States. American Association of University Women Career Development Grants

December 15, 2017

Funding to women who hold a bachelor's degree and are preparing to advance or change careers or reenter the workforce. Primary consideration is given to women of color and women pursuing their first advanced degree or credentials in nontraditional fields.

P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship

December 15, 2017 (Deadline for Eligibility Form)

The International Peace Scholarship Fund, established in 1949, is a program which provides scholarships for selected women from other countries for graduate study in the United States and Canada. Members of P.E.O. believe that education is fundamental to world peace and understanding.

Golden Key Graduate Scholar Award

December 15, 2017

Scholarship for members who have proven academic excellence combined with a solid range of extracurricular activities.

IMA Applied Research Grant

December 20, 2017

Funds work that will help bridge the gap between academics and management accounting professionals while contributing to the development of knowledge in the profession.

U.S. Department of Defense

SMART Fellowship through the Department of Defense (DoD)

December 1, 2017

Supports undergraduate and graduate students pursuing degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics disciplines. The program aims to increase the number of civilian scientists and engineers working at DoD laboratories.

National Defense Science and Engineering Graduate Fellowship

December 31, 2017

Designed to increase the number of U.S. citizens and nationals trained in science and engineering disciplines of military importance. The DoD will offer these fellowships to individuals who have demonstrated the ability and special aptitude for advanced training in science and engineering.

Harriet Evelyn Wallace Doctoral Student Scholarships for Women

January 3, 2018

Scholarships support female geoscientists pursuing a graduate degree. Scholarships provide two years of support. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

Guy Harvey Scholarship Award

January 5, 2018 (anticipated)

Supports graduate students who are enrolled full time at Florida institutions of higher education who are conducting research related to the biology, ecology, habitat or management of fish in Florida's marine environment.

American Association of Family & Consumer Sciences National Graduate Fellowship

January 8, 2018

Awards graduate fellowships to individuals who have exhibited the potential to make contributions to the family and consumer sciences profession. The field of family and consumer sciences (FCS) encompasses the study of relationships among people and their personal environments in order to strengthen communities and advance the well-being of individuals and families over their lifespan.

American Water Works Association

January 9, 2018

Bryant L. Bench Scholarship

Provides support to a master's student engaging in developing innovative solutions to the world's water challenges.

Hazen and Sawyer Scholarship

Provides support to a student seeking a master's degree in the water science field.

HDR/Henry "Bud" Benjes Scholarship

Provides support to a master's student seeking a degree in the water industry.

January 15, 2018

McKnight Doctoral Fellowship

January 15, 2018

Designed to address the under-representation of African American and Hispanic faculty at colleges and universities in Florida by increasing the pool of candidates qualified with Ph. D. degrees to teach at the college and university levels.

IMA Incubator Grant Program

January 15, 2018

Grants for smaller innovative projects related to accounting and finance.

International Literacy Association

January 15, 2018

Elva Knight Research Grant

Grant for research in reading and literacy

Jeanne S. Chall Research Fellowship

Grant to support reading research by promising scholars.

Steven A. Stahl Research Grant

Support for graduate students who have at least three years of teaching experience and who are conducting classroom research

Dr. Raymond A. Weiss Research Endowment

January 19, 2018

Established for ACSM students studying exercise science. One project will be funded for applied research, with the intent of applying the results to programs involving physical activity and sports. Arthur C. Pike Scholarship in Meteorology

November 10, 2017 (anticipated)

A scholarship from the National Weather Association for students majoring in meteorology.

Charlotte W. Newcombe Doctoral Dissertation Fellowship

November 15, 2017

Dissertation stage support for doctoral students whose work offers significant potential for advancing academic scholarship related to ethics and/or religion.

Internships with the Middle East Program

November 15, 2017

The Program concentrates on long-term developments and how such issues impact stability and growth in the region and its relations with the United States. The Middle East Program's meetings, conferences and reports assess the policy implications of regional developments (political, economic, and social), the Middle East's role in the international arena, American interests in the region, strategic threats to and from the regional states, and the role and future prospects of the region's energy resources.

Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services Science Policy Fellowship

November 27, 2017

The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services offers an outstanding opportunity for a Science Policy Fellow. The Fellow will be a critical member of the Science Advisory team that works across the department to foster cutting edge, interdisciplinary studies under the guidance of the department's Deputy Commissioner and Chief Science Officer. December 1, 2017

The foundation's mission is promoting the conservation of savannas, gallery forests, wetlands, and associated ecosystems in Central and South America. The Student Grant Program (SGP) was designed in response to feedback from Venezuelan professors. Graduate student research projects are often hindered by lack of funds for basic needs such as transportation, lodging, meals and consumable field supplies. Open to Latin American students enrolled in a M.S. or Ph.D. program in a US or South American university.

Kate Neal Kinley Memorial Fellowship

December 1, 2017

Open to students whose principal or major studies have been in the fields of art, architecture, dance, landscape architecture, music, theatre, or urban and regional planning.

UNCF-Merck Graduate Science Research Dissertation Fellowships

December 1, 2017 (anticipated)

Open to African American students who are engaged in and within 1-3 years of completing their dissertation research and enrolled full-time in a Ph.D. or equivalent doctoral degree program.

Doris Duke Fellowship for the Promotion of Child Well-Being

December 1, 2017

The Fellowships are designed to identify and develop a new generation of leaders interested in and capable of creating practice and policy initiatives that will enhance child development and improve the nation's ability to prevent all forms of child maltreatment.

Romance Writers of America Academic Research Grant

December 1, 2017

Up to \$5,000 to develop and support academic research devoted to genre romance novels, writers, and readers. The ultimate goal of the proposals should be significant publication in major journals or as a monograph from an academic press. RWA does not fund creative work (such as novels or films). December 16, 2017 (anticipated)

Both nine-month (\$21,000) and summer (\$7,000) fellowships for PhD students researching analytical chemistry.

December 20, 2017

American Medical Association Seed Grant Research Program

December 20, 2017

National Institutes of Health

NIH Ruth L. Kirschstein National Research Service Award (F31)

December 8, 2017

The purpose of the Kirschstein-NRSA predoctoral fellowship (F31) award is to enable promising predoctoral students to obtain individualized, mentored research training from outstanding faculty sponsors while conducting dissertation research in scientific health-related fields relevant to the missions of the participating NIH Institutes and Centers. Supports significant research by master's and doctoral students whose research addresses education finance and policy.

Association for Education Finance Policy Jean Flanigan Outstanding Dissertation Award

Award in recognition of exemplary dissertation research in the area of education finance and policy.

Harriet Evelyn Wallace Doctoral Student Scholarships for Women

January 3, 2018

Scholarships support female geoscientists pursuing a graduate degree. Scholarships provide two years of support. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

Guy Harvey Scholarship Award

January 5, 2018 (anticipated)

Supports graduate students who are enrolled full time at Florida institutions of higher education who are conducting research related to the biology, ecology, habitat or management of fish in Florida's marine environment.

American Association of Family & Consumer Sciences National Graduate Fellowship

January 8, 2018

Awards graduate fellowships to individuals who have exhibited the potential to make contributions to the family and consumer sciences profession. The field of family and consumer sciences (FCS) encompasses the study of relationships among people and their personal environments in order to strengthen communities and advance the well-being of individuals and families over their lifespan.

American Water Works Association

January 9, 2018

Roy W. Likins Scholarship

Scholarships for students pursuing a degree relating to the drinking water industry.

Abel Wolman Fellowship

Supports promising doctoral students in the US, Canada, and Mexico pursuing advanced training and research in the field of water supply and treatment.


