Things to consider...

- ◇ **Identify Fellowship and Award opportunities based on “Fit”**
- ◇ **Organize Funding Search Results**
- ◇ **Dedicate time to prepare and request materials needed to complete the application**
- ◇ **Revision Process (Draft, Review, Revise, Repeat)**
- ◇ **Awards are generally disbursed 6-12 months from the application deadline**

Application Components

Fellowship and award applications have a lot of moving parts. To develop a strong and compelling fellowship application, determine:

1. Is the funding opportunity a good fit for you and your academic, research/work, and/or personal interests?
2. Are you a good fit for the funding opportunity?
3. **KNOW YOUR AUDIENCE** - What are the reviewers looking for (mission of the funding opportunity, criteria for review)?

- ◇ Personal Statement
- ◇ Research Proposal
- ◇ Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume
- ◇ Letters of Recommendation
- ◇ Timeline and Budget Justification

Scholarships, Fellowships, and Awards

Advancing Research Impact in Society (ARIS) Center - Fellowship Program

ARIS Center fellowships support professionals, researchers, faculty, educators, graduate students, and others working to advance the practice and improve the outcomes of research impacts **Deadline: September**

American Academy in Rome - Rome Prize

The prize is awarded to emerging artists and scholars in the arts and humanities for independent study at the American Academy in Rome where they may expand their own professional, artistic, or scholarly pursuits. **Deadline: November**

American Antiquarian Society (AAS) - Short-Term Visiting Research Fellowships

Fellowships support doctoral students conducting research on pre-20th century United States history and culture using the Society's collections. **Deadline: January**

American Association of Family and Consumer Sciences (AAFCS) - Graduate Fellowships

Fellowships support graduate students studying family and consumer sciences. **Deadline: January**

American Association of University Women (AAUW) – Fellowships and Grants **Deadline: November**

AAUW American Fellowship

1-year dissertation completion fellowship open to women pursuing a doctoral degree. Students in all fields of study at an accredited institution of higher education are eligible. U.S. citizenship is required. Provides a \$25,000 stipend.

AAUW International Fellowship

Provides support for women pursuing full-time graduate or postdoctoral study in the United States who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents, and who intend to return to their home country to pursue a professional career. Award is open to students in all disciplines and to master's and doctoral programs. Provides \$20,000 to master's students, \$25,000 for doctoral students.

AAUW Career Development Grant

Provides funding to women who hold a bachelor's degree and are preparing to advance or change careers or re-enter the workforce in education; health and medical sciences; science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM); or social sciences. Must have been out

of school for eight years before returning for graduate program. Awards range from \$2,000 to \$20,000.

American Brahms Society - Karl Geiringer Dissertation Completion Scholarship in Brahms Studies

Scholarships support advanced graduate research in historical musicology, analysis, performance practice, cultural history, and related fields. **Deadline: March**

American Center of Oriental Research (ACOR) in Amman, Jordan - Pre-doctoral and Postdoctoral Fellowships

Fellowships promote an increased knowledge of ancient and Middle Eastern studies with Jordan as a focus. **Deadline: February**

American Council of the Blind (ACB) and American Foundation for the Blind (AFB) - Scholarships for Blind and Visually Impaired Students

Educational scholarships ranging from \$2,000 to \$7,500 for entering freshman, undergraduate and graduate students and those attending technical college. **Deadline: February**

American Handel Society - J. Merrill Knapp Research Fellowship

Fellowships support scholarly projects related to Handel and his world. Requests for funding may include but are not limited to, purchase of microfilms, travel for research, and production expenses for publication. **Deadline: March**

American Indian College Fund - Full Circle Graduate Scholarship

Scholarships support American Indian and Alaska Native students pursuing a graduate or professional degree at any university. **Deadline: May**

American Institute of Bangladesh Studies (AIBS) - Dissertation Research Fellowships

Fellowships support students in all academic disciplines conducting or preparing to conduct research involving Bangladesh. **Deadline: September**

American Institute of Indian Studies (AIIS) - Dissertation Fellowships

Fellowships support dissertation research in India conducted in pursuit of knowledge about India, its people and culture. **Deadline: November**

American Musicological Society (AMS) - Alvin H. Johnson Dissertation Fellowship

These fellowships support doctoral students in musicology who are in the dissertation writing phase of their program. **Deadline: February**

American Musicological Society (AMS) - Holmes / D’Accone Dissertation Fellowship in Opera Studies

The Holmes/D’Accone Opera Studies Fellowship for dissertation research recognizes academic achievement and future promise in the study of opera. **Deadline: February**

American Musicological Society (AMS) - Howard Mayer Brown PhD Fellowship

Fellowships support minority scholars and teachers in musicology who are members of a group historically underrepresented in the discipline, including African Americans, Native Americans, Hispanic Americans, and Asian Americans and, in Canada, aboriginal peoples and visible minorities (as defined by Canadian legislation). **Deadline: February**

American Society for Theatre Research (ASTR) - Helen Krich Chinok Dissertation Travel Fellowship

Fellowships assist Ph.D. candidates with the expenses of travel to national or international collections to conduct research projects connected with their dissertations. Ph.D. candidates must have passed their qualifying exams within the last two years (or by June of the current year) and have begun working on their dissertations. **Deadline: July**

American-Scandinavian Foundation (ASF) - Award for Scandinavians

The American-Scandinavian Foundation (ASF) offers funding to Scandinavians to undertake study or research programs in the United States for up to one year. **Deadline: Varies**

American-Scandinavian Foundation (ASF) - Fellowships & Grants to Study in Scandinavia

The American-Scandinavian Foundation (ASF) promotes the firsthand exchange of intellectual and creative influence between the United States and the Nordic countries: Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. **Deadline: November**

Archaeological Institute of America (AIA) - Elizabeth Bartman Museum Graduate or Post-Master’s Internship

The fund assists graduate students or those who have recently completed a master’s degree in archaeology or a related field meet expenses associated with undertaking a museum internship (minimum duration a summer or semester). **Deadline: April**

Armenian Students’ Association (ASA) - Scholarship

ASA offers scholarships for students of Armenian descent at accredited colleges and universities. **Deadline: March**

Aspen Music Festival and School (AMFS) - Scholarships & Fellowships for Musicians

The Aspen Music Festival and School is the country’s premier summer music festival,

offering a combination of intensive one-on-one instruction and professional performance experience. **Deadline: Varies**

Association for Slavic, East European & Eurasian Studies (ASEEES) - Research Funding Opportunities

Research grants of up to \$6,000 for dissertation research in Eastern Europe and Eurasia on any aspect of Slavic, East European, and Eurasian studies in any discipline **Deadline: Varies depending on the grant (see website)**

Association for Slavic, East European & Eurasian Studies - Summer Dissertation Writing Grant

Grants of up to \$6,000 for summer dissertation writing on any aspect of Slavic, East European, and Eurasian studies in any discipline. **Deadline: April**

Association of Moving Image Archivists (AMIA) - Scholarships

The Association of Moving Image Archivists offers financial assistance to graduate and professional students wishing to pursue careers in moving image archiving. **Deadline: May**

Belgian American Educational Foundation (BAEF) - Doctoral and Postdoctoral Fellowships for Study or Research in Belgium

BAEF offers fellowships for advanced study or research at a Belgian university or institution of higher learning. **Deadline: October**

BMI Foundation - Scholarships for Young Composers, Performers, and Radio Broadcasting Degree Candidates

Scholarships support the creation, performance, and study of music. **Deadline: Varies (see website)**

Boston University / West African Research Association (WARA) - Short-Term Travel Fellowship

Fellowships support graduate research to enhance transatlantic exchange and collaboration **Deadline: February**

Camargo Foundation - Residential Fellowships in France

The Camargo Foundation, located in Cassis, France, offers residential fellowships to researchers, scholars, choreographers, writers, playwrights, composers, and visual artists. **Deadline: October**

Caring.com - Student-Caregiver Scholarship

The Student-Caregiver Scholarship provides financial assistance to students who are caring for an adult relative while enrolled in college. **Deadline: Varies depending on the scholarship**

Center for Reintegration - Baer Scholarship for Students with Mental Illness

Scholarships support students with schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, or bipolar disorder to acquire the educational and vocational skills necessary to reintegrate into society, secure jobs, and regain their lives. **Deadline: January**

Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory (CSHL) - Sydney Brenner Research Scholarship in the History of Molecular Biology, Genetics, and Biotechnology

Scholarships support scholars, journalists, writers, filmmakers, and creative artists undertaking substantial research into the history of the life sciences using, but not limited to the collections at Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory Archives. **Deadline: March**

Consortium for Faculty Diversity at Liberal Arts Colleges - Dissertation & Postdoctoral Fellowships

Offers residential fellowships in all disciplines of the liberal arts at Consortium member institutions for the purpose of promoting diversity in the academy. **Deadline: Varies depending on the Fellowship**

Costume Society of America (CSA) - Stella Blum Student Research Travel Grant

Grants support student members of the CSA conducting original research in the field of North American costume. **Deadline: August**

Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art - Tyson Scholars Program

Fellowships support full-time residential scholarship in American art history, Indigenous art, Latin American art, contemporary art, architecture, visual and material culture, and American studies. **Deadline: December**

DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service)

Long-Term Research Grants for Doctoral Students

Support doctoral candidates who wish to conduct research or obtain training in Germany. Grants are available for long-term projects lasting 7-12 months, and projects may be in any academic discipline. **Deadline: October**

Scholarship for Summer Language Study at German Universities

Scholarships to attend a broad range of 3-4-week summer language courses at German universities which focus mainly on German language and literary, cultural, political, and economic aspects of modern and contemporary Germany. **Deadline: December**

Dartmouth College - Eastman/Marshall/Chávez Dissertation Completion Fellowships for Underrepresented Students

Fellowships promote student and faculty diversity at Dartmouth College, and throughout higher education, by supporting completion of the doctorate by underrepresented minority scholars and other graduate scholars with a demonstrated commitment and ability to advance educational diversity. **Deadline: January**

Dartmouth University - Program in African American Studies - Thurgood Marshall Dissertation Fellowship

The Thurgood Marshall Dissertation Fellowship supports completion of the doctorate by underrepresented minority scholars and other graduate scholars with a demonstrated commitment and ability to advance educational diversity. **Deadline: February**

Dedalus Foundation - Dissertation Fellowship in Modern Art

The fellowship supports dissertation research related to painting, sculpture, and allied arts from 1940-1991, with a preference shown to Abstract Expressionism. **Deadline: December**

Diversifying Higher Education Faculty in Illinois (DFI) Fellowship Program

Offered by the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE), DFI fellowships support underrepresented graduate students who intend to teach or become administrators in higher education in the state of Illinois following graduation. **Deadline: November**

Duke University Research Funding - Louise Wallace Hackney Fellowship for the Study of Chinese Art

The Fellowship supports the study of Chinese art, with special emphasis on painting and its reflection of Chinese culture. **Deadline: March**

Environmental Design Research Association (EDRA) / Urban Communication Foundation - Michael Brill Research Grant

The Michael Brill Research Grant supports research that seeks to enhance the quality of community life by examining communicative behavior in the context of the technologies and the physical environments in which those interactions occur. **Deadline: November**

Finlandia Foundation National (FNN) - Scholarships for Graduate Study

FNN awards scholarships to full-time undergraduate and graduate students of all academic disciplines who are currently enrolled in accredited post-secondary schools in the United States and Finland. **Deadlines: February**

Florida International University (FIU) - Cuban Research Institute (CRI) - Díaz-Ayala Library Travel Grants

The Cuban Research Institute offers short-term travel grants to support research about Cuba and

its diaspora at the FIU Green Library in Miami, FL. **Deadline: March**

Frank Huntington Beebe Fund for Musicians - Study Abroad Fellowship

The Fund provides fellowships for gifted young musicians, generally, performers and composers in classical disciplines, who wish to pursue advanced music study and performance abroad, usually in Europe. **Deadline: December**

Gamma Mu Foundation - Scholarship

Scholarships support gay men who want to further their education at a college, university, or vocational or professional training program. **Deadlines: March**

Garden Club of America (GCA) / Landscape Architecture Foundation (LAF) - Douglas Dockery Thomas Fellowship in Garden History & Design

The fellowship supports graduate research on garden history and design, and examines the future of gardens and their unique place in our environment. **Deadlines: February**

Getty Research Institute - Dissertation & Postdoctoral Fellowships

Fellowships support emerging scholars to complete work on projects related to the Getty Research Institute’s annual theme that make use of the Getty collections. **Deadline: October**

Government of Alberta - Alberta Student Aid - Sir James Lougheed Graduate Scholarships

Scholarships support masters and doctoral students from Alberta with the opportunity for advanced study at educational institutions outside of Alberta. **Deadline: January**

Graham Foundation - Carter Manny Dissertation Research and Writing Fellowships

Fellowships support the completion of outstanding doctoral dissertations on architecture and its role in the arts, culture, and society. **Deadline: November**

Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America - Paleologos Scholarship for Non-Theological Graduate Studies

Scholarships are offered to students enrolled in full-time professional graduate studies leading to graduate, non-theological degrees. **Deadline: May**

Harvard University - Society of Fellows Program

Fellowships support dissertation completion and postdoctoral research in any department of the University **Deadline: August**

Henry Luce Foundation - Scholars Program for Study in Asia

The Henry Luce Foundation provides one-year professional internships in East or Southeast

Asia for those with little academic knowledge or experience of Asia. **Deadline: October**

Hobart and William Smith Colleges - Fisher Center for the Study of Women and Men - MFA and Predoctoral Fellowship

The fellowship supports MFAs and doctoral scholars whose work interrogates the 2021-2022 theme, “beyond”, in its many manifestations and as part of various political, artistic, philosophical, and scientific projects. **Deadlines: Vary depending on specific funding opportunity**

Horovitz Fund - Fellowship for African Artists & Scholars in the Humanities & Social Sciences

The Fund supports graduate study for African artists and scholars in the humanities and social sciences with an award to defray educational costs. **Deadline: April**

Inlaks Foundation - Scholarships for Indian Citizens

Scholarships are granted to Indians citizens pursuing graduate degrees at top American, European, and UK institutions, for funding requirements including tuition fees. **Deadline: March**

Islamic Scholarship Fund (ISF) - Scholarship for Study in the Humanities, Social Sciences and Liberal Arts

Scholarships support study and research in fields in which American Muslims are underrepresented in the humanities, liberal arts, social sciences, and law. **Deadline: March**

Japanese American Citizens League (JACL) - National Scholarship Program

Scholarships support National JACL members pursuing graduate study across all disciplines, including law, business, and medicine. **Deadline: May**

American Educational Research Association (AERA) Dissertation Grant

With support from the National Science Foundation, provides small grants for conducting studies of education policy and practice using federally funded, large-scale data sets. 1-year nonrenewable award of \$27,500. **Deadline: December**

Japanese Consulate Monbukagakusho (MEXT) - Scholarships for Graduate Research

Scholarships support independent research in Japan. Any field of study is eligible for the scholarship, but applicants must find a Japanese professor willing to supervise their research. **Deadline: June**

Josephine de Karman Fellowship Trust - Dissertation Fellowships

The Fellowships recognize and assist doctoral students whose scholastic achievements in any discipline reflect the highest standards. **Deadline: January**

Kenyon College - Marilyn Yarbrough Dissertation Completion/Teaching Fellowship

The fellowship supports scholars in a wide range of disciplines who come from underrepresented and disadvantaged backgrounds. **Deadline: December**

Kobe College Corporation/Japan Education Exchange - Graduate Fellowship for PhD Research in Japan

The Fellowships Program supports graduate students who wish to conduct research or study in Japan. **Deadline: April**

Korea Foundation - Korean Studies Graduate Fellowship Program

The Program is aimed at fostering a new generation of Korean Studies scholars by providing scholarship support to foreign students who are currently enrolled on an M.A. or Ph.D. program in Korean Studies working on a Korea-related topic in the humanities, social sciences, arts or cultural studies. **Deadline: September**

Kosciuszko Foundation - Scholarship for Study and Research in Poland

This scholarship supports graduate-level research at universities in Poland by American graduate students and university faculty members for one academic year (October-June) at Polish universities and institutions which fall under the jurisdiction of the Polish Ministry of Education. **Deadline: March**

Kosciuszko Foundation Tuition Scholarships support American students of Polish descent for full-time graduate studies in the United States - all fields are supported. **Deadline: January**

Residential fellowships support research projects related to the Museum's collections. **Deadline: Varies**

The Leonard A. Lauder Research Center for Modern Art is a leading center for scholarship on modern art. **Deadline: November**

Middlebury College - Kress Summer Fellowship for Language Study for Graduate Students in European Art History

Middlebury College offers fellowships for language study to art history graduate students to attend

the Middlebury summer Language Schools in French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Russian, or Spanish. **Deadline: December**

Mortar Board National Foundation - Fellowships

Scholarships support student members of the NAACP pursuing graduate studies. **Deadline: June**

National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) - Walter Byers Graduate Scholarship

This Program recognizing excellence in academic performance by student-athletes. **Deadline: January**

National Federation of the Blind (NFB) - Scholarships for Blind Students

The NFB annually offers scholarships to blind college students in the United States and Puerto Rico, to recognize achievement by blind scholars. **Deadline: March**

National Gallery of Art - Center for Advanced Study in the Visual Arts (CASVA) - Ailsa Mellon Bruce Predoctoral Fellowship for Historians of American Art to Travel Abroad

Fellowships enable doctoral students in art history who are studying aspects of art and architecture of the United States, including native and pre-Revolutionary America, to travel abroad in areas such as Africa, Asia, or South America, as well as Europe, to sites of historical and cultural interest, including museums, exhibitions, collections, and monuments. **Deadline: November**

National Italian American Foundation (NIAF) - Scholarships

Scholarships support Italian American students in their graduate studies. **Deadline: March**

National Organization of Italian American Women (NOIAW) - Scholarship

Scholarships support Italian American women pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree. **Deadline: April**

National Sporting Library & Museum (NSLM) - John H. Daniels Short-Term Research Fellowship Program

The fellowship supports research at the NSLM in history, art, literature, anthropology, and sport, with research projects ranging from the architecture of horse stables, history of horsemanship, equestrian fashion, and poetry, to falconry, veterinary science, environmental conservation and fly fishing. **Deadline: September**

New America Fellows Program

Job opportunities for involvement in a range of public policy issues including national security, technology, asset building, health, gender, energy, education, and the economy. **Deadline: Continuous, until positions are filled**

New York Public Library - Lapidus Center for the Historical Analysis of Transatlantic Slavery - Short-term Fellowship

Residential fellowships support research on the slave trade, slavery, abolition, and anti-slavery in the Atlantic World. Fellows have access to the resources of the Schomburg Center as well as those of other research units of the New York Public Library to further their research, including the Lapidus Center collection of 400 rare items of printed material. **Deadline: January**

New York Public Library - Short-term Research Fellowship

Fellowships support graduate-level, post-doctoral, and independent researchers from outside of the New York metropolitan area needing to conduct on-site research in the Library's special collections to support projects in the humanities, business, and the arts. **Deadline: January**

Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship & Financial Assistance (ONNSFA) - Graduate Fellowship

The Fellowship is established to provide financial assistance to eligible Navajo graduate students. **Deadlines: June and November**

Open Society Archives (OSA) - Central European University, Budapest - Visegrad Scholarship

Fellowships to support research at OSA archives in Budapest by individuals from the fields of history, the arts, philosophy, and sociology to reflect on the conditions of knowledge production

during and after the Cold War. **Deadlines: July and November**

Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in America (OSDIA) - Sons of Italy Foundation (SIF) - Scholarships for Graduate Students and Law Students of Italian Descent
Scholarships support graduate study by Italian-American students. **Deadline: March**

Organization of American States (OAS) - Graduate Scholarship
Scholarships are for full-time onsite or online studies leading to a Doctorate or Master’s degree at a university or higher learning education institution in an OAS Member State, with the exception of the applicant’s sponsoring country, in eight (8) priority areas of study. **Deadlines: Vary depending on the Scholarship**

Organization of American States (OAS) - Leo S. Rowe Pan American Fund
The Fund offers interest-free loans to citizens from Latin America and the Caribbean OAS Member States to finance their studies or research in accredited universities across the United States. **Deadline: Continuous**

Palestinian American Research Center (PARC) - Fellowship for Field Research in Palestinian Studies
Fellowships support research in Palestinian studies. **Deadline: February**

Pat Tillman Foundation - Tillman Military Scholarship for Veterans, Active Duty, and Family Members
Tillman Military Scholarships provide support to military service-members and spouses who are full-time undergraduate or graduate students in the fields of medicine, law, business, policy, technology, education and the arts. **Deadline: February**

Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowships for New Americans
Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowships support “New Americans,” i.e., green card holders, naturalized citizens, DACA recipients, asylees, refugees, or the children of immigrants, in any field and in any advanced degree-granting full-time program in the United States. **Deadline: October**

PEO Scholarships and Awards – opportunities for women pursuing graduate degrees (see website for deadlines)

PEO Scholar Award
This award is for women doctoral students within two years of graduation but with at least one full year of their program remaining at the start of the award term. The award provides \$20,000 but is only open to citizens of the U.S. or Canada. Contact the Office

PEO Program for Continuing Education
Intended for women graduate students who have been out of school for at least 24 months before beginning their graduate program, this merit and need-based award provides up to \$3,000 for educational expenses. Applicants should be within 18 months of completing their degree at time of application.

PEO International Peace Scholarship
This scholarship provides up to \$12,500 for international women students to pursue graduate study in the U.S. Applicants must have a year of coursework remaining at start of scholarship. Applications for eligibility documentation open in September.

Fellowships support the use of UCLA Library Special Collections’ extensive holdings in medieval and Renaissance manuscripts and printed books. **Deadline: April**

Western Sydney University / Australian-American Fulbright Commission - Scholarship for Research and Study in Select Fields

The Fulbright Postgraduate Scholarship, funded by Western Sydney University, supports research of importance to the bilateral relationship between the U.S. and Australia.

Deadline: October

Williams College - Gaius Charles Bolin Dissertation & Post-MFA Residency Fellowship for Underrepresented Students

Fellowships support scholars and artists pursuing careers in college teaching who will promote diversity on college faculties. **Deadline: November**

Winterthur Museum - Short-term, Dissertation, & Postdoctoral Fellowships

Advanced doctoral students are eligible to apply. **Deadline: January**

Yellow Barn - Chamber Music Summer Program

A summer chamber music program supports outstanding students and young professionals. Participants explore chamber music repertoire with an internationally renowned faculty, rehearsing and performing together in 20 concerts at the Big Barn, an intimate concert hall in Putney, Vermont. Repertoire ranges from the Baroque period to the present day, and often affords participants the opportunity of working with visiting composers. **Deadlines: January**

YIVO Institute for Jewish Research - Short-Term Fellowships for Jewish Studies

Fellowships support scholarly research in YIVO’s library and archival collections of Yiddish books, documents, and other artifacts related to the history of East European Jewry. Each fellowship requires a public lecture by the holder, to be held during or immediately after the fellow’s research period. General Graduate Fellowships are available to graduate women working on a professional degree, masters, doctoral or enrolled in postdoctoral study. **Deadline: February**
