- ◇ **Revision Process (Draft, Review, Revise, Repeat)**
- ◇ **Awards are generally disbursed 6-12 months from the application deadline**

# Application Components

Fellowship and award applications have a lot of moving parts. To develop a strong and compelling fellowship application, determine:

1. Is the funding opportunity a good fit for you and your academic, research/work, and/or personal interests?
2. Are you a good fit for the funding opportunity?
3. **KNOW YOUR AUDIENCE** - What are the reviewers looking for (mission of the funding opportunity, criteria for review)?

- ◇ Personal Statement
- ◇ Research Proposal
- ◇ Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume
- ◇ Letters of Recommendation
- ◇ Timeline and Budget Justification

**Academy of Natural Sciences of Philadelphia - Jessup & McHenry Short-Term Research Awards**

Grants support research under the supervision or sponsorship of a member of the curatorial staff of the Academy. The award duration is 2-16 weeks. **Deadlines: March and October**

**Acoustical Society of America (ASA) - Beranek Graduate Scholarship in Architectural Acoustics and Noise Control**

The fellowship supports a student pursuing a graduate degree in architectural acoustics and noise control. **Deadline: March**

**Acoustical Society of America (ASA) - Winker Memorial Scholarship for Graduate Study in Acoustics**

The scholarship supports a student pursuing a graduate degree in architectural acoustics, noise control, and engineering acoustics, including, but not limited to, applications of linear and nonlinear acoustics, transduction and transducers, acoustical measurements, instrumentation, and applications of signal processing to any of the aforementioned areas. **Deadline: March**

**Adobe Research - Ph.D. Fellowship**

Fellowships support graduate student research in the areas of artificial intelligence & machine learning; AR, VR & 360 photography; audio; computer vision, imaging & video; content intelligence; data intelligence; document intelligence; graphics (2D & 3D); human computer interaction; intelligent agents & assistants; natural language processing; and systems & languages. **Deadline: September**

**Air & Waste Management Association (A&WMA) - Graduate Scholarships**

A&WMA offers scholarships to graduate students who are pursuing courses of study and research leading to careers in air quality, waste management, environmental management/policy/law, and sustainability. **Deadline: January**

**Airport Cooperative Research Program (ACRP) - Graduate Research Award on Public Sector Aviation Issues**

Fellowships support graduate applied research on airport and related aviation system issues by individuals who may become the future airport managers, operators, designers, and policymakers in aviation. **Deadline: May**

**American Academy of Underwater Sciences (AAUS) - Graduate Research Scholarships**

Scholarships facilitate the development of safe and productive scientific divers through education, research and the advancement of standards for scientific diving practices, certifications and operations. **Deadline: June**

**American Association for Geodetic Surveying (AAGS) / National Society of Professional Surveyors (NSPS) - Graduate Fellowship**

The AAGS, through the National Society of Professional Surveyors Foundation (NSPS), awards

fellowships to graduate students enrolled in geo-spatial sciences and related programs, including surveying, mapping, geographic information systems, and geodetic science. **Deadline: June**

**American Association of Equine Practitioners (AAEP) - Foundation for the Horse - Graduate Student Research Grant**

The grant supports research on topics related to equine musculoskeletal, gastrointestinal, and metabolic disease, as well as laminitis and new technology development. **Deadline: June**

**American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG) - Grants-In-Aid (GIA) - Program for Graduate Students**

Grants support master's and doctoral students conducting research in the geosciences whose thesis research has application to the search for and development of petroleum and energy-mineral resources, and/or to related environmental geology issues. **Deadline: January**

**American Australian Association (AAA) - Fellowships for Research in Australia**

Fellowships support research or study in Australia in the fields of science, technology, engineering, mathematics, health, medicine, journalism, and sustainability. **Deadline: September**

**American Chemical Society - Division of Medicinal Chemistry Predoctoral Fellowships**

Fellowships support predoctoral students in their second or third year of graduate study (at the time of application) engaged in research in a Medicinal Chemistry, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Biochemistry, or Chemistry department listed in the current ACS Directory of Graduate Research. **Deadline: February**

**American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM) - Graduate Research Awards**

Awards support graduate student research in sports medicine and exercise science. **Deadline: September**

**American Concrete Institute (ACI) - Graduate Scholarships and Fellowships**

Fellowships and scholarships (see website for full list) that support graduate student members whose studies relate to concrete. **Deadline: July**

**American Council of the Blind (ACB) and American Foundation for the Blind (AFB) - Scholarships for Blind and Visually Impaired Students**

The American Foundation for the Blind (AFB) and American Council of the Blind (ACB) have partnered together to offer educational scholarships for those attending university as graduate students. **Deadline: February**

**American Federation for Aging Research (AFAR) / Diana Jacobs Kalman Scholarships - Graduate Research Grant in the Biology of Aging**

Grants support mentored research into the biology of aging. **Deadline: April**

**American Geographical Society (AGS) - Council Graduate Fellowship**

The fellowship supports graduate student scholarship in pursuit of geographical knowledge in any subfield of geography. AGS encourages, but does not require, a fieldwork component. **Deadline: November**

**American Geophysical Union (AGU) - Horton Doctoral Research Grant in Hydrological Sciences**

AGU grants support doctoral students in the hydrological sciences and related policy-oriented social sciences. **Deadline: April**

**American Heart Association (AHA) - Predoctoral Fellowship**

Fellowships support research and clinical training of promising students who are matriculated in predoctoral or clinical health professional degree training programs and who intend careers as scientists, physician-scientists, clinician-scientists, or other related careers aimed at improving global cardiovascular, cerebrovascular, and brain health. **Deadline: September**

**American Institute of Bangladesh Studies (AIBS) - Dissertation Research Fellowships**

Fellowships support students in all academic disciplines conducting or preparing to conduct research involving Bangladesh. These grants are supported by the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs through the Council of American Overseas Research Centers. **Deadline: December**

**American Institute of the History of Pharmacy - Thesis Support Grant**

Grants support doctoral research on some aspect of pharmacy, whether ancient or modern, to pay research expenses not normally met by the university granting the degree (see website for eligible project expenses). **Deadline: March**

**American Mathematical Society (AMS)/American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) - Mass Media Summer Fellowship Program**

AMS and AAAS jointly sponsor a ten-week summer fellowship through the Mass Media Science & Engineering Fellowship program. **Deadline: January**

**American Meteorological Society (AMS) - Fellowship in the History of Science**

AMS awards fellowships to students completing dissertations on the history of the atmospheric or related oceanic or hydrologic sciences. **Deadline: May**

**American Museum of Natural History (AMNH) - Chapman Small Grant Program**

The Chapman Small Grants Program awards grants to graduate students for research primarily focused on the systematics and evolutionary biology of birds. **Deadline: November**

**American Museum of Natural History (AMNH) - Small Grants**

The AMNH Grants Program offers modest short term awards to advanced students, postdoctoral trainees, and scientific researchers who are commencing their careers in the fields covered by

AMNH. **Deadlines: Between February and May annually**

**American Nuclear Society (ANS) - Graduate Scholarships**

ANS offers scholarships to graduate students in a program leading to an advanced degree in nuclear science, nuclear engineering, or a nuclear-related field. **Deadline: February**

**American Ornithological Society (AOU) - Research Grants**

AOU supports research in various areas of avian biology for students and postdoctoral researchers who are members of the American Ornithological Society. **Deadline: January** (no posted deadline is firm)

**American Philosophical Society (APS)**

- **Lewis & Clark Fund for Doctoral Student Field Research** - This grant supports exploratory field studies for the collection of specimens and data for direct observation. **Deadline: November**
- **NASA Astrobiology Institute - Lewis & Clark Fund for Exploration & Field Research in Astrobiology** - This grant supports field studies in any area of interest to astrobiology, including research in, among others, the fields of astronomy, chemistry, evolutionary biology, field and population biology, geology, microbiology, molecular biology, oceanography, paleontology, and planetary science. **Deadline: February**

**American Psychological Association (APA)**

- **Elizabeth Munsterberg Koppitz Child Psychology Graduate Fellowship** - The APA's Koppitz fellowship supports graduate research in child psychology including child-clinical, pediatric, school, educational, and developmental psychopathology. **Deadline: November**
- **Graduate Scholarships, Fellowships, & Grants** - The APA Foundation supports graduate research in psychology through the American Psychological Foundation (APF). **Deadline: Varies**

**American Society for Nutrition (ASN) - Predoctoral Fellowship**

The fellowship supports doctoral students in nutrition science. **Deadline: January**

**American Society of Agronomy (ASA) - Nelson Yield-Limiting Factors Graduate Scholarship**

Scholarships support graduate students whose goals are to research and develop improved diagnostic techniques and solutions to yield-limiting factors in agronomy. **Deadline: March**

**American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) - Graduate Fellowships**

Fellowships support graduate members of ASCE enrolled at accredited institutions. **Deadlines: Vary depending on specific Fellowship**

**American Society of Mammalogists (ASM) - Grants & Fellowships**

Grants and fellowships support graduate student members of the ASM engaged in research in any area of mammalogy to assist them in the early development of their careers. **Deadline: March**



**American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) - Graduate Teaching Fellowship**

The ASME Teaching Fellowship Program encourages outstanding graduate students, especially women and minorities, to pursue the doctorate in mechanical engineering and pursue engineering education as a profession. **Deadline: March**

**American Society of Naval Engineers (ASNE) - Scholarship**

Scholarships support graduate students in engineering or physical sciences who are pursuing an education and career in naval engineering. **Deadline: March**

**American Speech-Language-Hearing Foundation (ASHF) - Grants & Scholarships**

ASHF supports graduate students pursuing careers in communication sciences and disorders, speech-language pathology, audiology or hearing science, and related areas, that will improve the lives of people with speech, language, or hearing disorders. **Deadlines: Vary depending on specific Fellowship**

**American Water Works Association (AWWA) - Scholarships**

AWWA offers a variety of scholarships and fellowships and students enrolled at colleges or universities in the U.S. who are pursuing studies that will improve drinking water quality. Most scholarships offer support for one year. **Deadline: December**

**American-Scandinavian Foundation (ASF) - Award for Scandinavians**

The American-Scandinavian Foundation offers funding to Scandinavians to undertake study or research programs in the United States for up to one year. **Deadline: April**

**American-Scandinavian Foundation (ASF) - Fellowships & Grants to Study in Scandinavia**

The American-Scandinavian Foundation (ASF) promotes the firsthand exchange of intellectual and creative influence between the United States and the Nordic countries: Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. **Deadlines: November**

**Animal Behavior Society (ABS) - Small Graduate Research Grants**

ABS supports research in the animal behavioral sciences through several small grants. **Deadline: November**

**Atlantic Salmon Federation (ASF) / Federation du Saumon Atlantique - Olin Fellowship**

Fellowships support individuals seeking to improve their knowledge or skills in advanced fields while looking for solutions to current problems in Atlantic salmon biology, management, and conservation. **Deadline: March**

**Appleton-Whittell Research Ranch - Apacheria Fellowship**

AWRR supports research that will help preserve and protect the remaining grassland ecosystems in the American southwest. Apacheria fellowships support research that will demonstrate methods to safeguard and restore southwestern grasslands, and to assist policy makers and other citizens in the care and protection of the native ecosystems, natural resources, and quality of life. **Deadline: March**

**Argonne National Laboratory (ANL) - Graduate Student Programs**

Argonne National Laboratory offers opportunities for qualified graduate students who are engaged in work related to Argonne programs. Argonne is a science and engineering national research laboratory operated by the University of Chicago for the U.S. Department of Energy. **Deadline: Continuous**

**Armenian Students' Association (ASA) - Scholarship**

ASA offers scholarships for students of Armenian descent at accredited colleges and universities. **Deadline: March**

**Associated General Contractors (AGC) Education & Research Foundation - Graduate Scholarship**

Scholarships support graduate students in construction management and engineering programs in the United States. **Deadline: November**

**Association for Slavic, East European & Eurasian Studies (ASEEES) - Understanding Modern Russia Research Grant**

Grants of up to \$6,000 to support in-country research related to the rule of law, governance, economy, business, and society in Russia. The program aims to provide opportunities for young scholars to make connections with Russian peers and senior specialists, promoting long-term professional relations and fostering the next generation of Russia experts. **Deadline: April**

**Association of Field Ornithologists (AFO)**

- **Bergstrom Memorial Research** - Awards support field studies of birds by helping to support a specific research or analysis project. **Deadline: January**
- **Skutch Research Awards** - Grants support minimally invasive research into the life histories, especially social relations reproduction, of little known birds of the continental Neotropics, including Trinidad and Tobago. **Deadline: July**

**Autism Science Foundation (ASF) - Predoctoral, Postdoctoral, and Medical Student Research Fellowship**

Fellowships are for doctoral students, medical students, and postdoctoral fellows pursuing basic and clinical research relevant to autism spectrum disorders. **Deadline: December**

**Baxter International - Young Investigator Award**

Awards support graduate students and postdoctoral fellows conducting research that clearly and concisely demonstrates direct relevance to the practical application and understanding of the certain therapeutic areas. **Deadline:** (on hold until 2024)

**Belgian American Educational Foundation (BAEF) - Doctoral and Postdoctoral Fellowships for Study or Research in Belgium**

BAEF offers fellowships for advanced study or research at a Belgian university or institution of higher learning. **Deadline: October**

**Beta Phi Mu - Eugene Garfield Dissertation Writing Fellowship in Library & Information Science and Related Fields**

Fellowships support doctoral students working on their dissertations in Library and Information Science, Information Studies, Informatics, or a related field. **Deadline: March**

**Better Scientific Software (BSS) - Fellowship Program**

The Better Scientific Software Fellowship Program supports activities that improve developer productivity and software sustainability of scientific codes. Activities can include organizing a workshop, preparing a tutorial, or creating content to engage the scientific software community. **Deadline: September**

**Boehringer Ingelheim Fonds - Dissertation Fellowship for Biomedical Research**

Fellowships support experimental projects in the field of basic biomedical research that are aimed at elucidating basic biological phenomena of human life and acquiring new scientific knowledge. **Deadlines: February, June, and October**

**Boston University/West African Research Association (WARA) - Short-Term Travel Fellowship**

Fellowships support graduate research to enhance transatlantic exchange and collaboration. **Deadline: February**

**Caring.com - Student-Caregiver Scholarship**

The Student-Caregiver Scholarship provides financial assistance to students who are caring for an adult relative while enrolled in college. Caring.com will award two annual scholarships to help recipients cover the costs of tuition and books. **Deadlines: Between September and December**

**Cave Research Foundation (CRF) - Philip M. Smith Graduate Research Grant**

Grants support graduate student research in cave and karst studies leading to either a master's or doctoral degree. **Deadline: March**

**Center for Reintegration - Baer Scholarship for Students with Mental Illness**

Scholarships support students with schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, or bipolar disorder to acquire the educational and vocational skills necessary to reintegrate into society, secure jobs, and regain their lives. **Deadline: January**

**Charles Babbage Institute (CBI) - Tomash Fellowship in the History of Information Technology**

The fellowship supports dissertation research in the history of computing. **Deadline: January**

**Chi Epsilon (Civil Engineering Honor Society) - Graduate Fellowship**

The fellowship supports a graduate student member of Chi Epsilon pursuing a career in civil engineering or a directly associated engineering option. **Deadline: February**

**Coalition for Networked Information (CNI) - Paul Evan Peters Fellowship**

Fellowships assist students pursuing graduate studies in the information sciences, librarianship, or closely related field, that advance the frontiers of digital information and technology. **Deadline: May**

**Children's Tumor Foundation (CTF) - Young Investigator Award - Doctoral/Postdoctoral Fellowships for Neurofibromatosis Research**

CTF seeks to support early-career scientists pursuing neurofibromatosis (NF) research. Research topics may include: manifestations of all types of NF1, NF2, schwannomatosis, including neurofibromas, schwannomas, malignant peripheral nerve sheath tumors, and other brain and nervous system tumors; bone abnormalities; cardiovascular abnormalities; learning disorders; and pain. **Deadline: February**

**Council for Advancement of Science Writing - Taylor/Blakeslee University Fellowship**

Fellowships support students in graduate-level programs in science writing, including science writing about medicine, health, technology, and the environment for the public. **Deadline: March**

**Council of American Overseas Research Centers (CAORC) - Multi-Country Dissertation Fellowships**

CAORC offers a fellowship program that supports advanced regional or trans-regional research in the humanities, social sciences, or allied natural sciences. **Deadline: December**

**Croucher Foundation - Doctoral Scholarship for Students from Hong Kong**

Fellowships provide financial support for promising young people in Hong Kong who are looking to pursue scientific research at a doctoral level outside Hong Kong. **Deadlines: November**

**D. Kim Foundation for the History of Science and Technology in East Asia - Graduate and Postdoctoral Fellowships & Travel Grant**

The Foundation provides fellowships and grants to support graduate students working in the history of science and technology in modern East Asia, regardless of their nationality, origins, or gender. Comparative studies of East Asia and the West as well as studies in related fields (mathematics, medicine and public health) are also welcome. **Deadline: December**

**DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service)**

- **Graduate Research Internship in Science and Engineering (RISE)** - Research internships in Germany offer a working experience abroad to master's and PhD students from North America at German companies and non-university research institutions with strong industry relations. **Deadline: December**
- **Long-Term Research Grants for Doctoral Students** - DAAD grants support doctoral candidates who wish to conduct research or obtain training in Germany. **Deadline: November**
- **Scholarship for Summer Language Study at German Universities** - Scholarships to attend a broad range of 3- to 4-week summer language courses at German universities which focus mainly on German language and literary, cultural, political, and economic aspects of modern and contemporary Germany. **Deadline: December**



**Dan David Prize - Doctoral Scholarship**

The Prize aims to foster universal values of excellence, creativity, justice, democracy and progress and to promote the scientific, technological and humanistic achievements that advance and improve the world. **Deadline: September**

**Department of Defense (DOD) - National Defense Science and Engineering Graduate (NDSEG) Fellowship**

The Department of Defense (DOD) offers the NDSEG fellowship as a means of increasing the number of U.S. citizens and nationals trained in science and engineering disciplines of military importance. **Deadline: October**

**Directed Energy Professional Society (DEPS) - Graduate Scholarships in High Energy Laser & High Power Microwave Technologies**

Scholarships support graduate students in the DE technology areas of High Energy Laser (HEL) and High Power Microwave Technologies (HPMT). **Deadline: April**

**Dobility, Inc. - SurveyCTO Data Collection Research Grant**

The SurveyCTO Data Collection Research Grant assists graduate students in data collection-related research who are undergoing (or about to undertake) a data collection-heavy project. **Deadline: September**

**Earthquake Engineering Research Institute (EERI) / Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) - Graduate Fellowship in Earthquake Hazard Reduction**

Fellowships offer support for research that contributes to the science and practice of earthquake hazard mitigation and fits with the goals and activities of the National Earthquake Hazards Reduction Program. **Deadline: May**

**Eat Right Foundation - Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics - Graduate Scholarships**

Scholarships are available to graduate students in fields relating to nutrition and dietetics. **Deadline: April**

**Educational Testing Services (ETS) - Summer Research Internship Program**

Interns participate in research under the guidance of an ETS mentor. The internship is carried out in the ETS offices in Princeton, N.J., in selected annual research areas (see website). **Deadline: Varies depending on specific program**

**Embassy of France - Chateaubriand Fellowships for Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, & Health Research in France**

Fellowships support doctoral students enrolled at U.S. universities wishing to conduct their research in a French laboratory as part of a co-supervised research project. The fellowship aims to initiate or reinforce research collaborations, partnerships, or joint projects. **Deadline: February**

**EMDR Foundation - Sandra Wilson Memorial Doctoral Dissertation Grant for Mental Health Research**

Grants support dissertation expenses related to research to study the effectiveness of Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) in one of the following priority areas: advancing evidence based practice, addressing the global burden of trauma, and building clinical evidence. **Deadlines: February and July**

**Environmental Defense Fund (EDF) - Climate Corps - Summer Fellowship**

Summer Fellowships give graduate students from a variety of disciplines an opportunity to work for a summer with companies and public institutions to identify ways to reduce emissions in their operations and supply chains and meet climate commitments. **Deadlines: November**

**Environmental Research & Education Foundation (EREF) - Scholarships in Waste Management Research & Education**

Scholarships support master's and doctoral students in waste management research and education. **Deadline: March**

**Epilepsy Foundation/American Epilepsy Society - Predoctoral Fellowship**

Fellowships support predoctoral students pursuing dissertation research with an epilepsy-relevant theme, and who are working under the supervision of a mentor with expertise to supervise in the area of epilepsy investigation. **Deadline: January**

**European Society for Clinical Nutrition and Metabolism (ESPEN) - Doctoral and Postdoctoral Fellowship**

Fellowships support doctoral and postdoctoral experimental and clinical research in the field of clinical nutrition and metabolism. **Deadline: April**

**Experiment.com - Crowdfunding for Scientific Research**

Experiment is an online platform for discovering, funding, and sharing science. **Deadline: Continuous**

**Explorers Club - Exploration Fund - Grants for Exploration and Field Research**

The Exploration Fund Grant supports exploration and field research for those who are just beginning their research careers. **Deadline: Continuous**

**Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory - Universities Research Association, Inc. (URA) - Visiting Scholars Program**

The program supports visits by researchers from the URA member institutions to work at Fermilab for periods of up to one year. **Deadlines: February and August**

**Finlandia Foundation National (FNN) - Scholarships for Graduate Study**

FNN awards scholarships to full-time undergraduate and graduate students of all academic disciplines who are currently enrolled in accredited post-secondary schools in the United States and Finland. **Deadline: February**

**Foundation for Food and Agriculture Research (FFAR) - Fellows Program**

The FFAR Fellows Program provides professional development and career guidance to the next generation of food and agriculture scientists across the Foundation. **Deadlines: February and April**

**Foundation for Women’s Wellness (FWW) - Doctoral/Medical Student Fellowship**

Fellowships support basic, clinical or epidemiological lines of inquiry into leading women’s health concerns. **Deadline: April**

**FRAXA Research Foundation - Research Fellowships**

FRAXA awards fellowships to researchers working in established labs on projects related to FRAXA’s Research Areas. **Deadline: Continuous**

**Garden Club of America (GCA) - Scholarships**

Scholarships support graduate students and postdocs, often in partnership with other institutions, in the areas of horticulture and its related disciplines including: medicinal and tropical botany, native bird habitat, conservation and ecological restoration, desert studies, landscape architecture, urban forestry, garden history and design, coastal wetlands, and pollinator research. **Deadline: Varies**

- **GCA Center for Coastal Resources Management - Graduate Scholarship in Coastal Wetlands Studies** - The scholarship supports a graduate student carrying out field-based research to promote wetlands conservation. **Deadline: January**
- **GCA Beattie Fellowship for Conservation Horticulture** - Fellowships support graduate research that will promote conservation of rare and endangered flora in the United States for work at a botanical garden by the student, who jointly serves the program of the Center for Plant Conservation (CPC) and their curricular studies. **Deadline: January**
- **GCA Cornell Ornithology Lab - Frances M. Peacock Scholarship for Native Bird Habitats** The scholarship provides financial aid to study areas in the United States that provide seasonal habitat for threatened or endangered native birds and to tend useful information for land-management decisions. **Deadline: March**
- **GCA Missouri Botanical Garden - Anne S. Chatham Fellowship in Medicinal Botany** The fellowship supports research related to medicinal plants and may be used for travel, field studies, or laboratory research. **Deadline: January**
- **GCA University of Wisconsin-Madison Arboretum - Fellowship in Ecological Restoration** Fellowships support graduate research on ecological restoration that assists the recovery and management of ecological integrity. **Deadline: December**

**Geological Society of America (GSA) - Graduate Research Grant**

GSA research grants provide partial support of master’s and doctoral thesis research in the geological sciences for graduate students enrolled in universities in the United States, Canada, Mexico and Central America. **Deadline: February**
