Supports basic scientific research on the causes, consequences, and complexities of human social and cultural variability. Provides support to enhance and improve the conduct of doctoral dissertation projects carried out by doctoral students enrolled in U.S. universities.

Doctoral Research Fellowship in Environmental Science

August 27, 2018 (anticipated)

Supports the study, analysis and solution of environmental problems, the management and regulation of natural resources, research and development and environmental education. The SETAC / Procter & Gamble Fellowship for Doctoral Research in Environmental Science, sponsored by the Procter & Gamble Company, will provide \$15,000 (USD) for 1-year Ph.D. studies.
